# FEMA Region 6 Weather Threat Briefing

Monday, January 19, 2026

# Summary

- **Winter Weather:**

- Arctic front is expected to bring a much colder air mass across FEMA 6 later this week.
- Moisture originating from the Baja region may interact with this cold front, bringing the potential for mixed wintry precip for portions of FEMA 6 on Fri-Sun.
- Timing of the front is uncertain, which leads to high uncertainty for precip type and amounts for later this week and weekend.

- **Fire Weather:**

- Locally elevated (level 1 of 3) fire weather concerns in the TX/OK Panhandles tomorrow afternoon.






**Locally elevated (level 1 of 3) fire weather concerns in the TX/OK Panhandles in the afternoon.**






# Tomorrow's Tornado & Severe Wind / Hail Probabilities




