



Here's our new storm total snow amounts for what is left of this event. The higher end totals are leading more towards the south and eastern Texas Panhandle.



Wintry weather is underway across much of North Texas this morning, and will continue spreading into Central Texas later today. A mix of freezing rain and sleet will affect most of the area, including isolated occurrences heavy thundersleet at times. A full changeover to sleet and some snow is expected across parts of North Texas by Sunday morning, before wintry weather ends on Sunday afternoon.

→ This Evening through Sunday Evening

→ Snow/Sleet accumulations of 2" - 4", especially in locations within the **Winter Storm Warning**.

→ Ice accumulations of 1/4" - 3/4", with isolated totals in excess of one inch, especially in locations within the **Ice Storm Warning**.

Ice accretion may bring trees and powerlines down. Very slippery roads, bridges, and walkways. Travel will be near impossible. Prepare for hazardous conditions. Prolonged power outages in cold weather.

Forecast Ice Accumulation Totals - Saturday Night - Sunday

- Significant ice accumulations of a quarter to half inch is expected across parts of central Louisiana and Southeast Texas. Northern tier counties / Parishes may see up to three quarters of an inch.
- Some ice accumulation is possible along the I-10 corridor, but totals are expected to be less than a tenth of an inch.

A Winter Storm Warning is in effect for most of the region this afternoon through mid-day Sunday. Expect to see periods of freezing rain, sleet, and snow during this timeframe. By Saturday night into early Sunday morning, the wintry mix will transition to mainly snow for areas north of the I-10 corridor. Besides the wintry precipitation, dangerous cold temperatures are certain beginning tonight lasting through the early part of next week.



Keetch-Byram Drought Index


