





SMALL CRAFT ADVISORY AREA

A Cold Weather Advisory is in effect for the entire Four State Region from Midnight Friday through Noon Saturday. Wind chills will range from the single digits north of Interstate 20, to the low to mid teens south of Interstate 20.

There is a Small Craft Advisory in effect from 5 AM this morning through at least 3 PM Saturday afternoon. Expect north winds 15 to 25 knots with gusts to 30 knots and seas ranging from 5-8 feet.






Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Keetch-Byram Drought Index


