



Arctic Air For This Weekend


Below freezing temperatures forecasted into Sun night



Key Messages

- A secondary surge of arctic air will move through the area today with brisk north winds keeping temperatures struggling to reach 40 degrees along with no significant precipitation. The windy and dry conditions will bring about a fire danger risk on Saturday afternoon.
- Hard freeze temperatures along with dangerous wind chills into Sunday morning.
- Some modification in temperatures on Sunday night into Monday morning, however freezing temperatures still expected for a majority of the area.
- Conditions will begin to warm during Monday.





Keetch-Byram Drought Index


