








Wind Speeds

- Rel. Humidity as low as 20-30%



A Fire Danger Statement is in effect from 10 AM this morning until 6 PM this evening for all of Deep South Texas except for the coastal and island counties.

Behind the front early this morning, north to northeast winds of 15-20 mph with gusts to 25 mph will persist through the afternoon. These moderate to strong winds in combination of relative humidity 20-30% will lead to an elevated fire weather risk for inland portions of South Texas through 7 PM this evening.









Report of 153 (+13) fires and 3,517 (+907) acres have been burned this year. There are 119 (+3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 128 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
