



→ Avoid open flames or sparks


→ Keep vehicles off dry grass







Report of 157 (+4) fires and 3,582 (+65) acres have been burned this year. There are 120 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 126 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
