






Wind Speeds

Rain Chances Tonight-Tuesday Night

Key Messages

- Light rain begins in southwest Texas tonight, before spreading northeast into the higher terrain in the early morning hours.
- On and off scattered light rain showers are expected across much of west Texas and southeast New Mexico Tuesday afternoon into the evening.

Amounts

- Most areas are expected to receive a trace to 0.1".
- Highest rainfall amounts expected for areas west of the Pecos River with 0.2-0.5" for some locations.






Keetch-Byram Drought Index


