





 → Impacts include large hail, strong winds, frequent lightning, and areas of moderate to heavy rainfall.

! Safety Precautions
 Friday afternoon through Saturday morning
 Never attempt to walk or drive through flowing flood waters
 Have a Way to Receive Warnings


An approaching upper level disturbance will pass through with a cold frontal boundary on Friday and Saturday. This will support strong to severe thunderstorms. The area in dark green has the highest risk for seeing the severe thunderstorms.

Dense Fog Advisory

DENSE FOG ADVISORY

Inland: Now through 10 AM Friday
 Marine: Now through 10 AM Friday

- Inland:** All counties and parishes along and south of I-10
- Marine:** All lakes, bays, and Gulf marine zones
- Widespread visibilities below 1 nm
- At times below ¼ mile
- Slow down & increase distance
- Turn on low-beam headlights
- Mariners use proper fog signals, running light, radar, and compass



Widespread dense fog can be expected tonight with visibilities below 1 nm, however visibilities below a quarter nm are possible. Fog may become patchy at times or transition to low cloud ceilings. Guidance supports dense fog having longer persistence along the immediate coast and into the ship channels.









Keetch-Byram Drought Index


