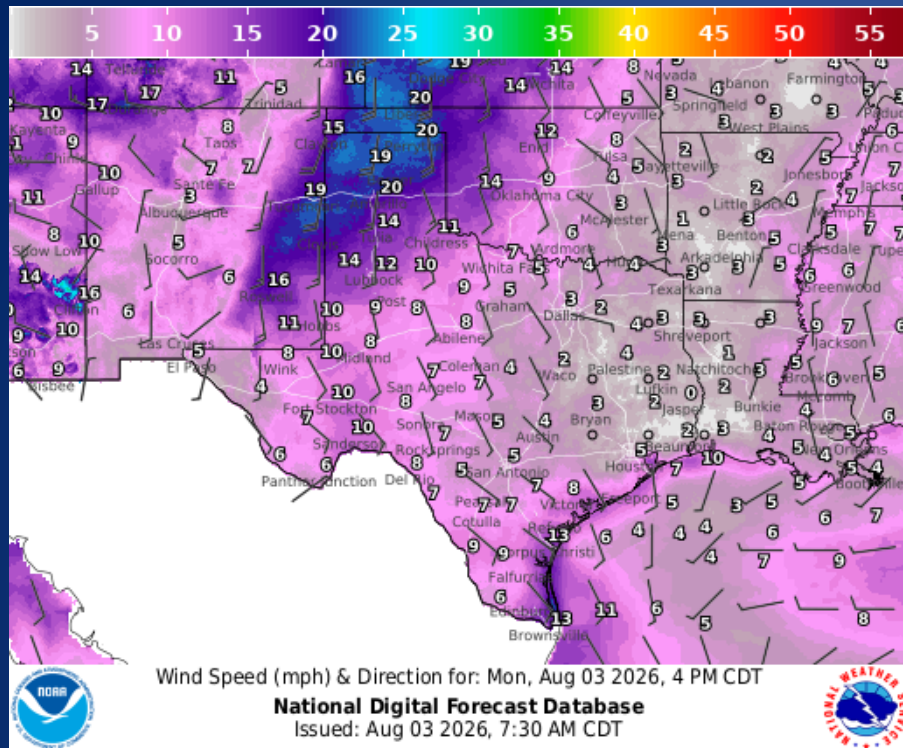

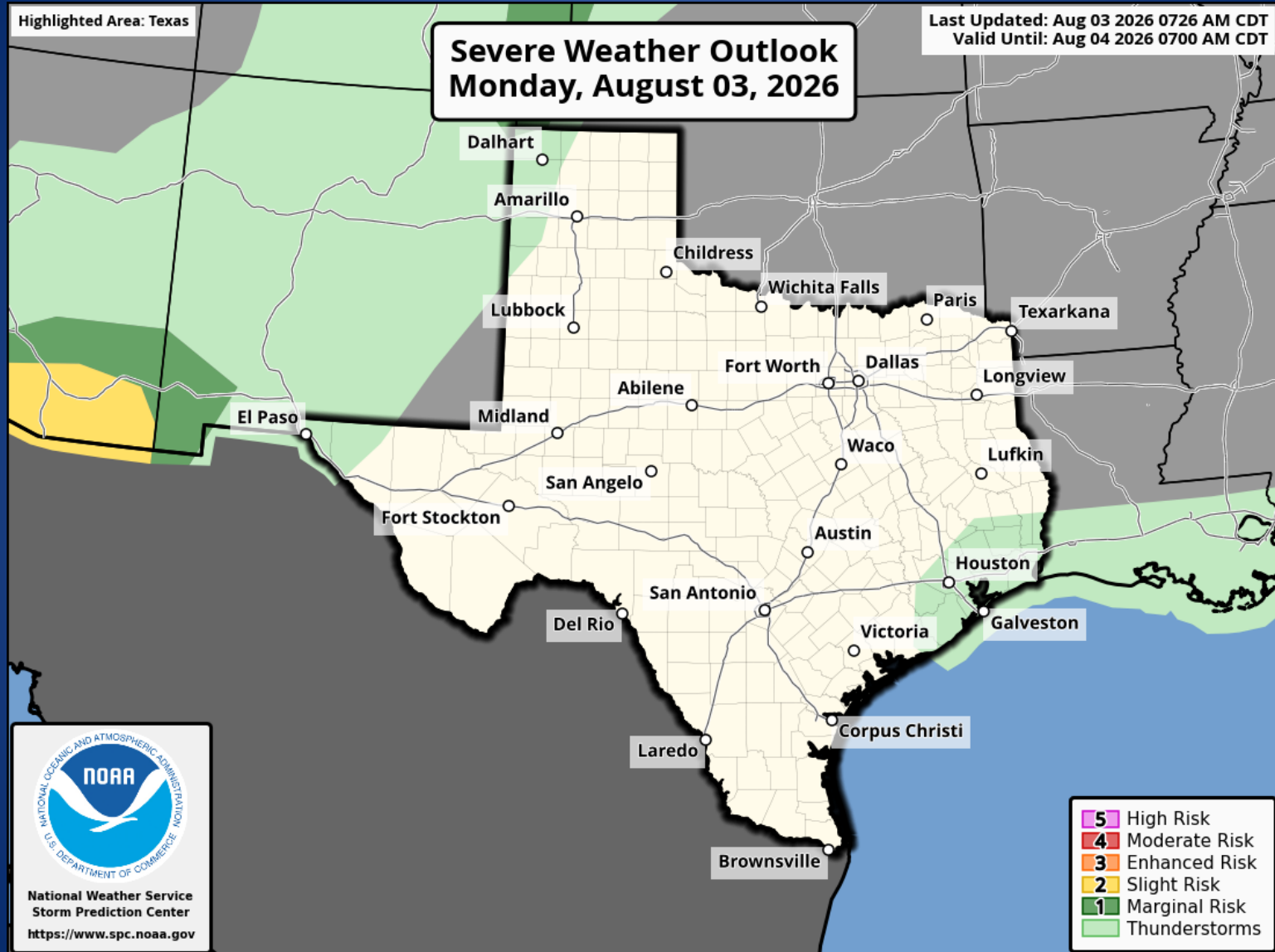

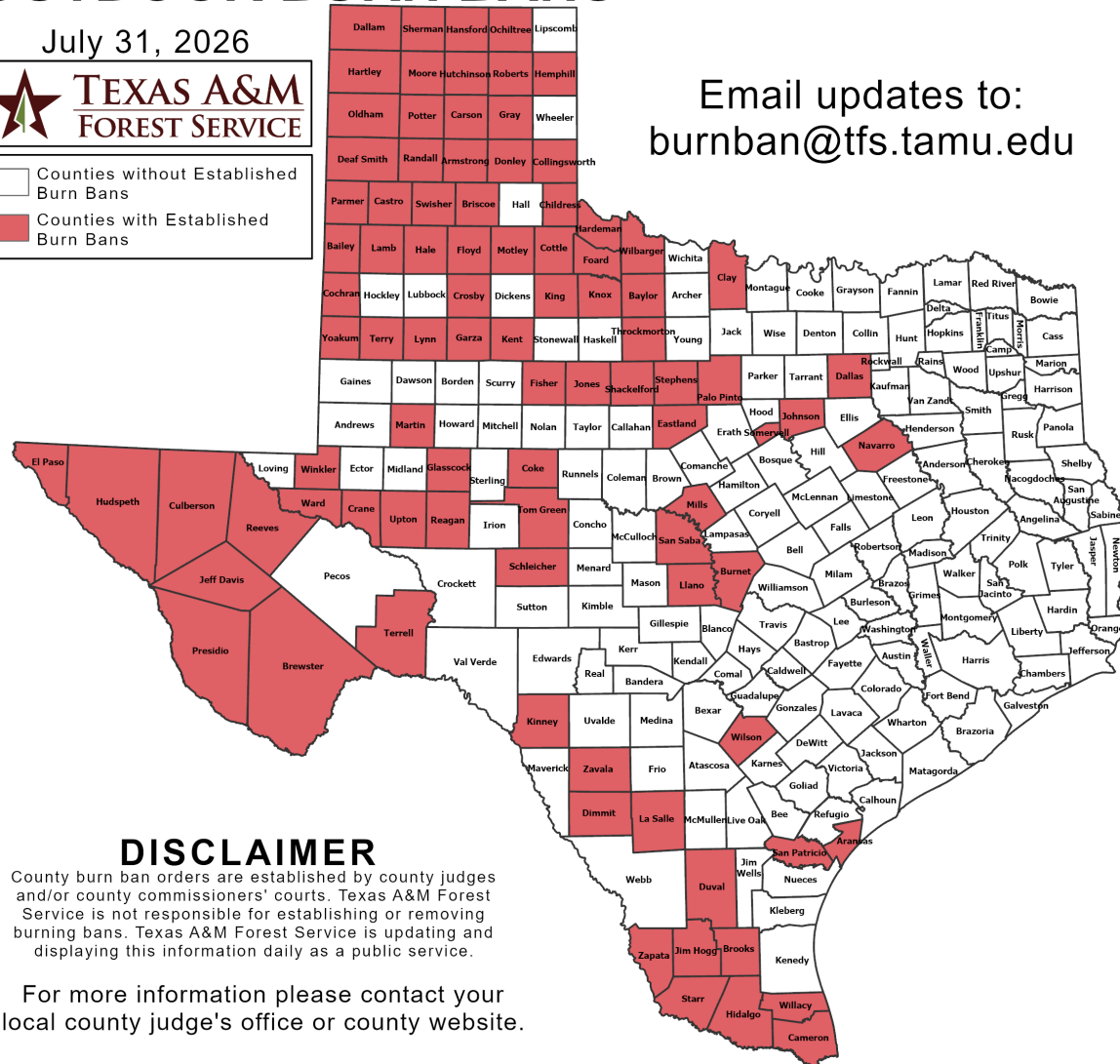

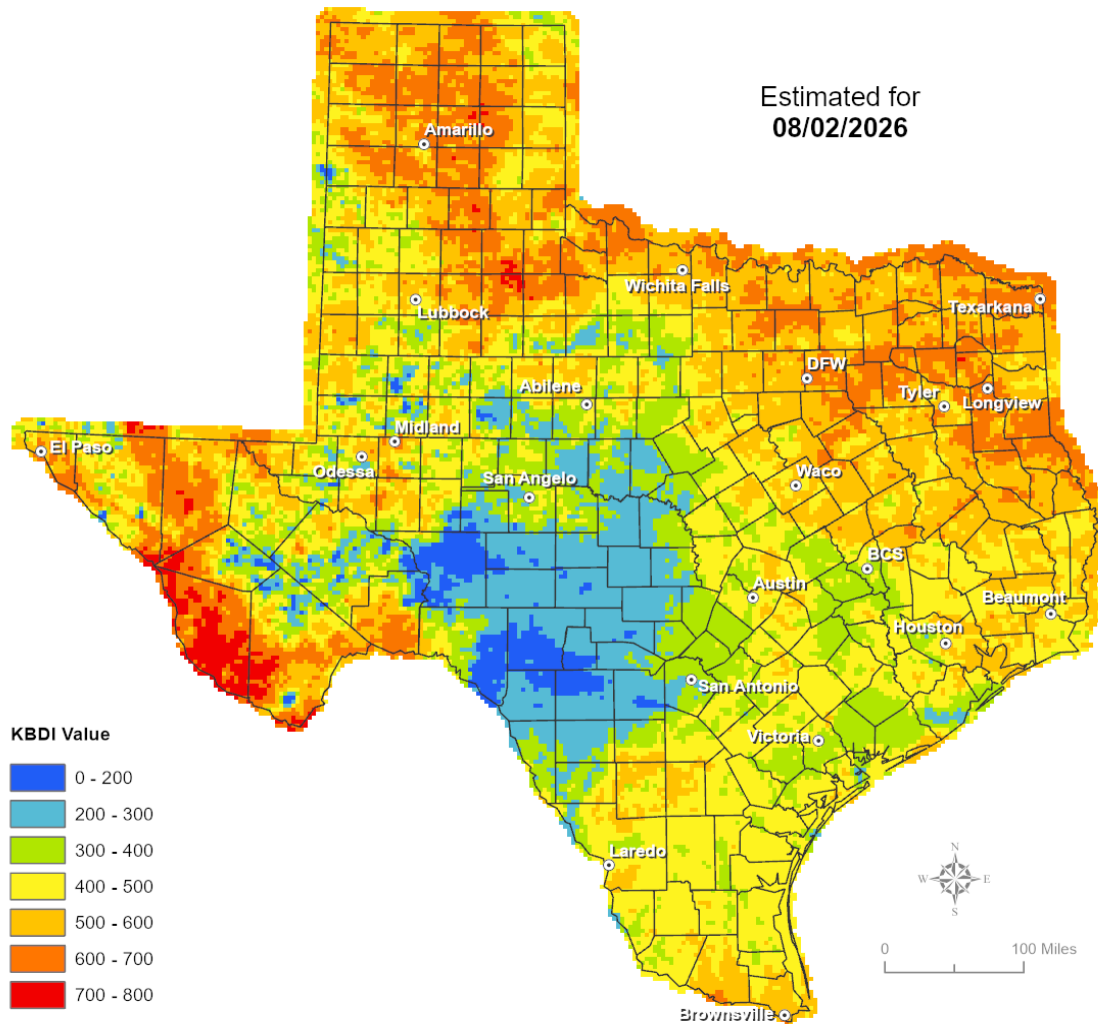

# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 768 fires (No Change) and 108,439 (No Change) acres have been burned this year. There are 91 (No Change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 192 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
