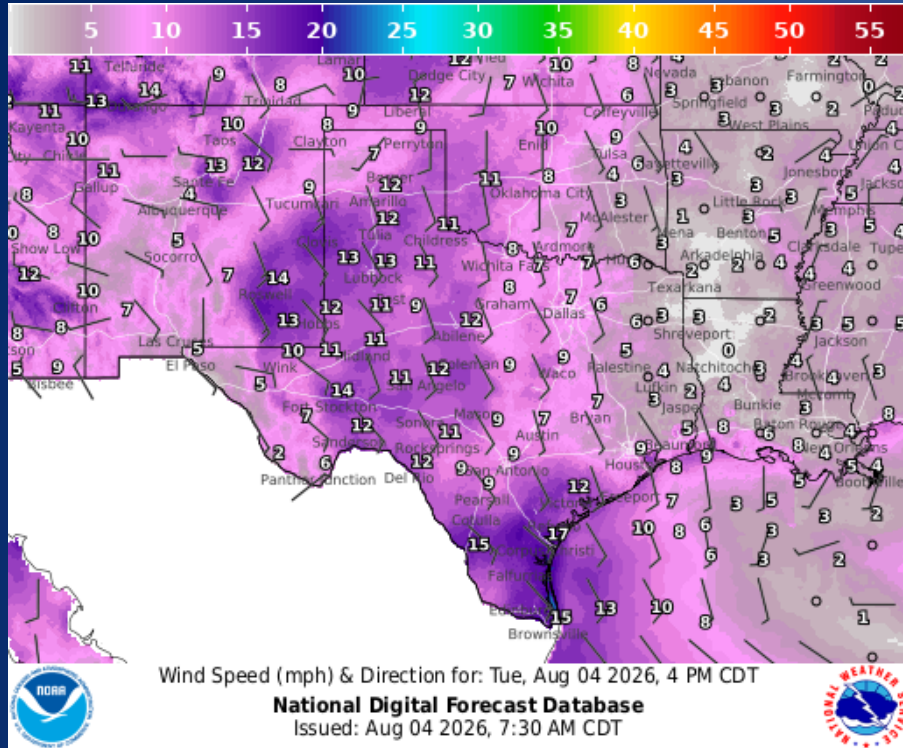

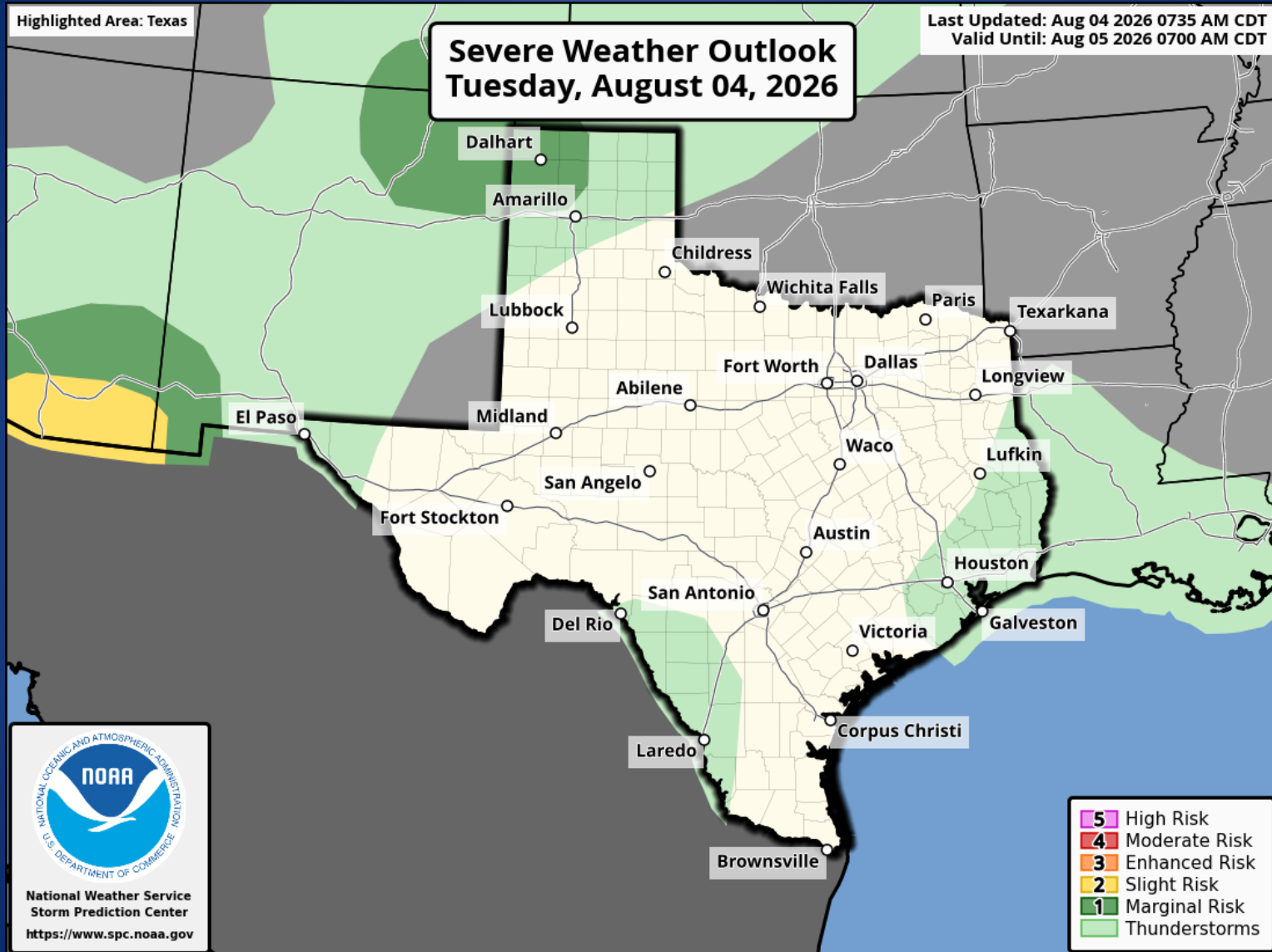

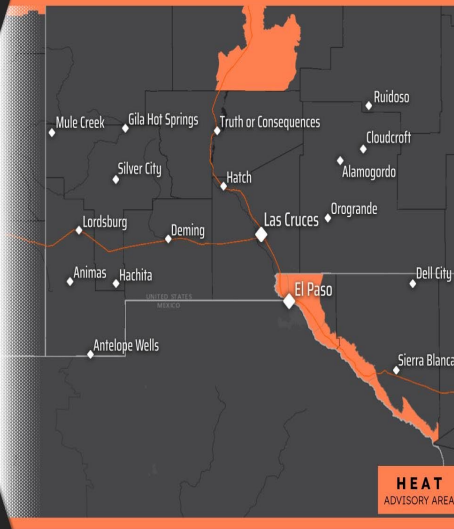

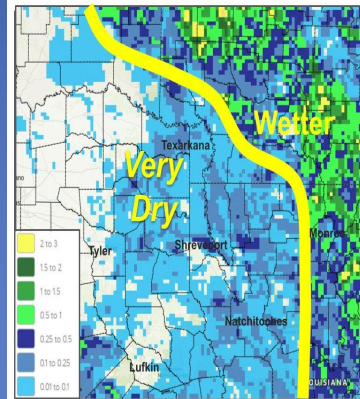

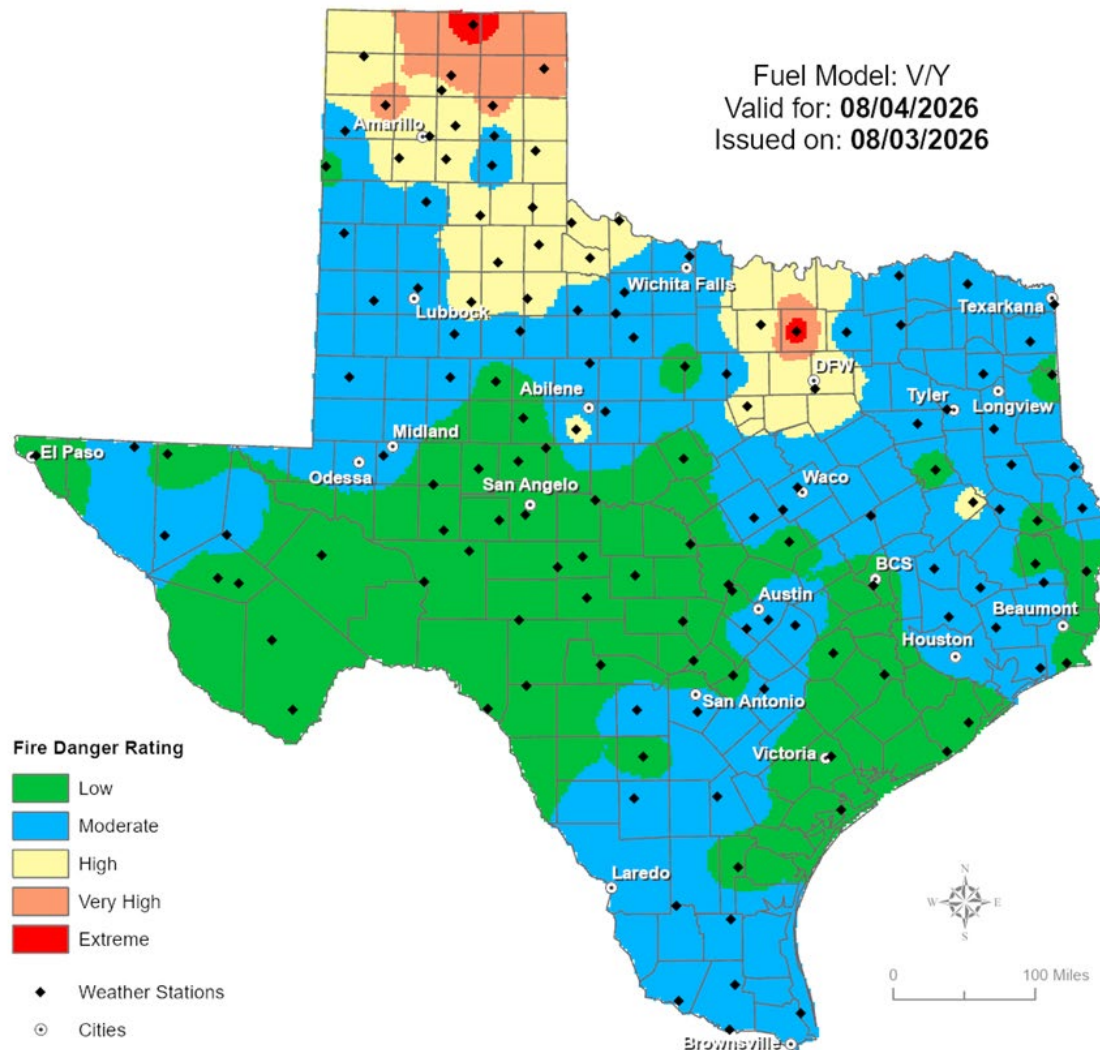

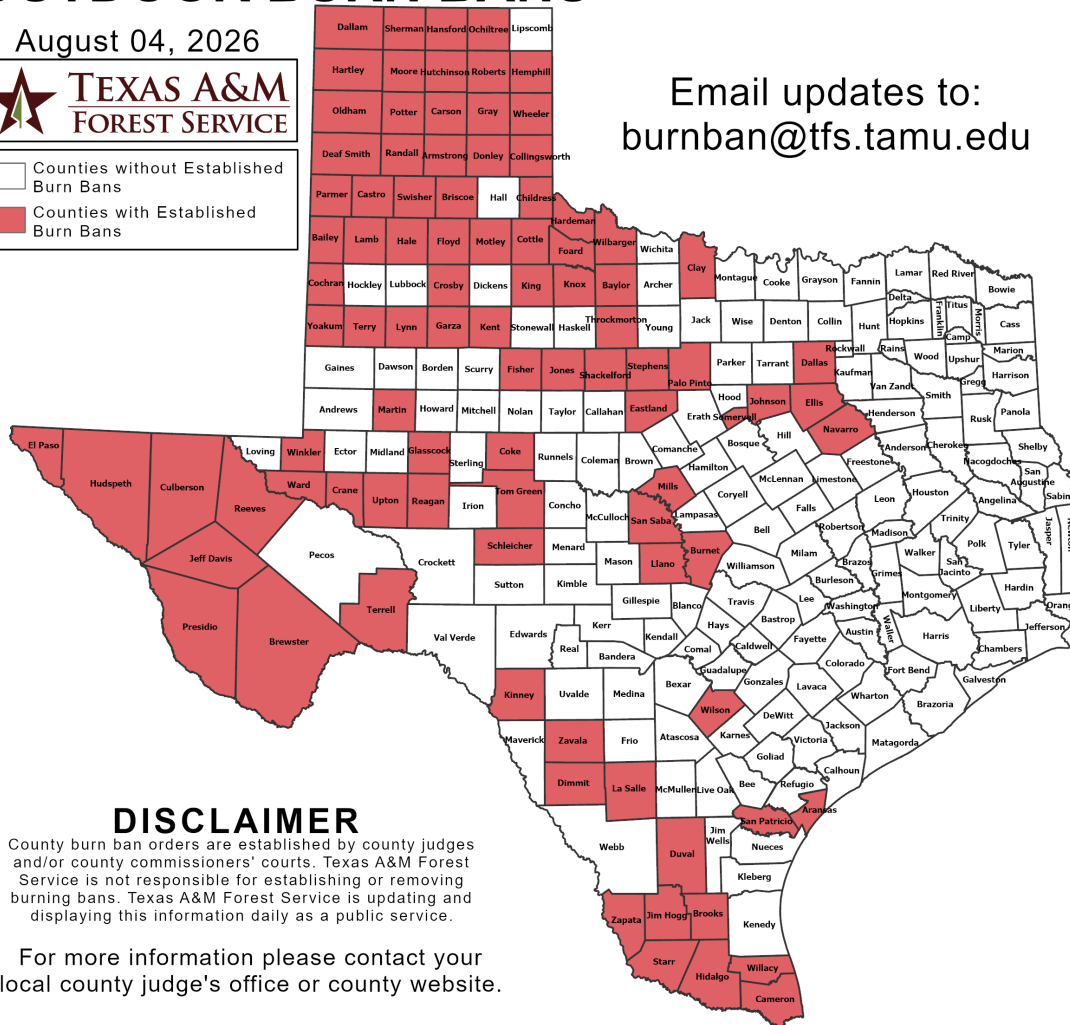

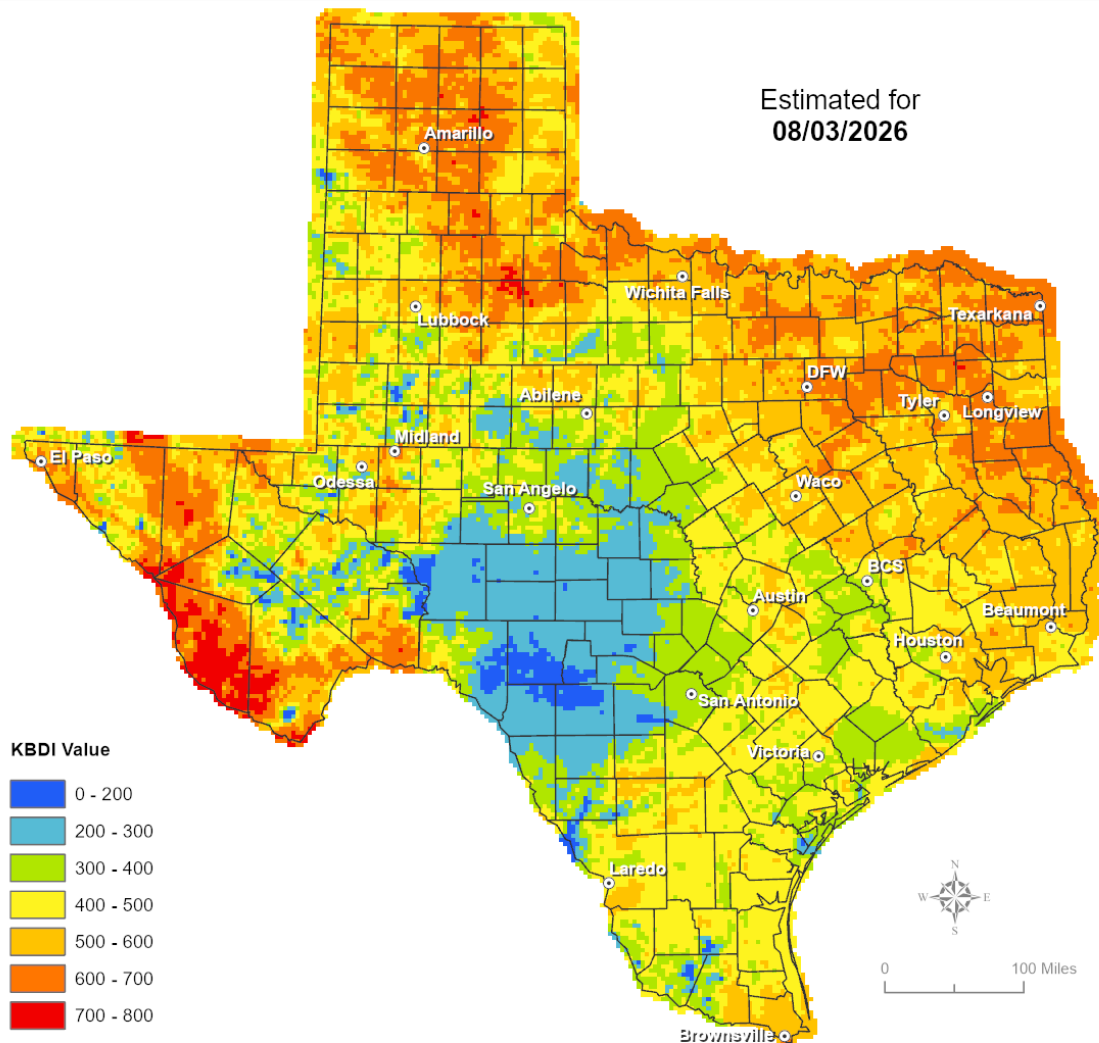

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Report of 792 fires (+24) and 108,811 (+372) acres have been burned this year. There are 93 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 202 (+10) counties with an average over 400.
