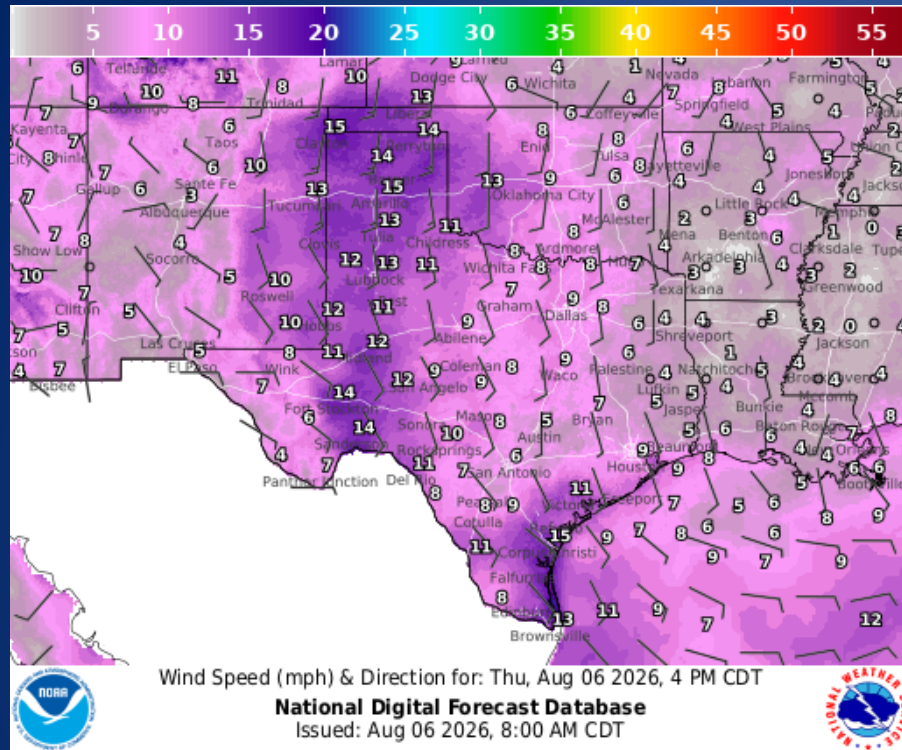

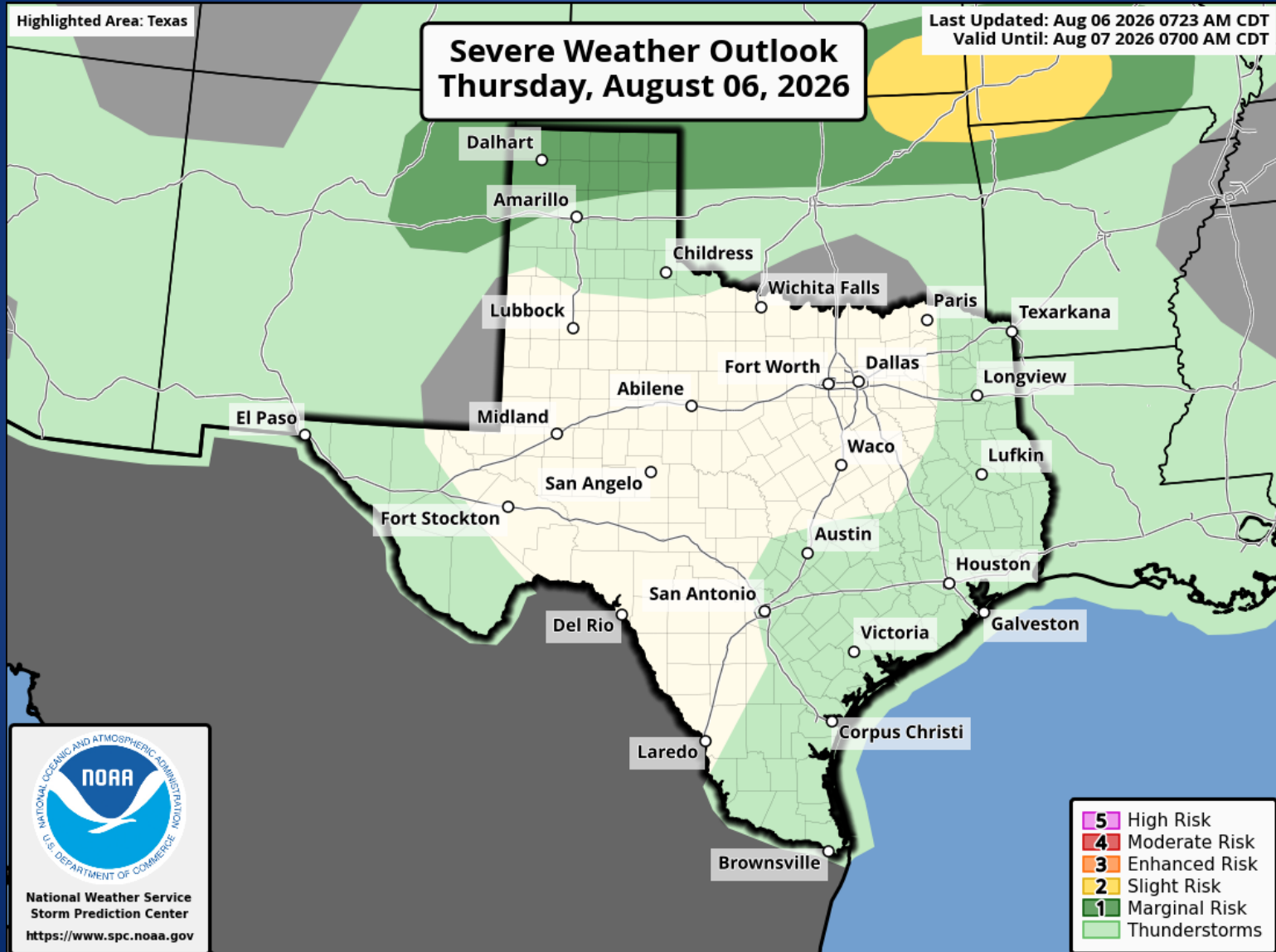

Today: Moderate to Major Heat Risk

Practice Heat Safety to Prevent Heat-Related Illnesses



Key Messages

- High temperatures ranging from 95-105°F this afternoon
- Peak heat indices ranging from 106-114°F
- **Moderate** (level 2 of 4) Heat Risk to **Major** (level 3 of 4) Heat Risk

in air conditioning or shade



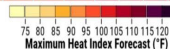

Isolated storms west of the Divide



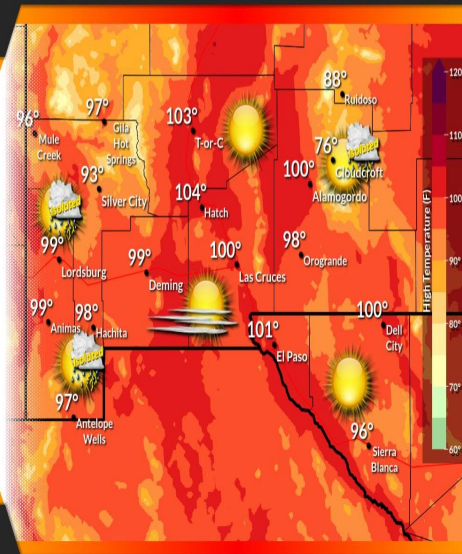
Heat Advisory in effect for El Paso and the Rio Grande Valley from 12 PM to 9 PM Tuesday.

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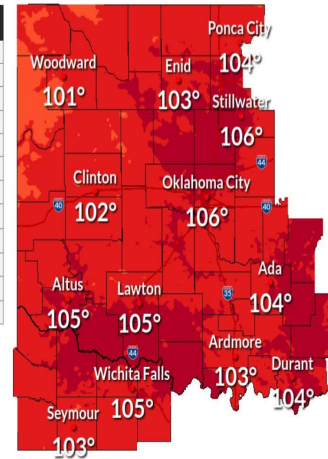

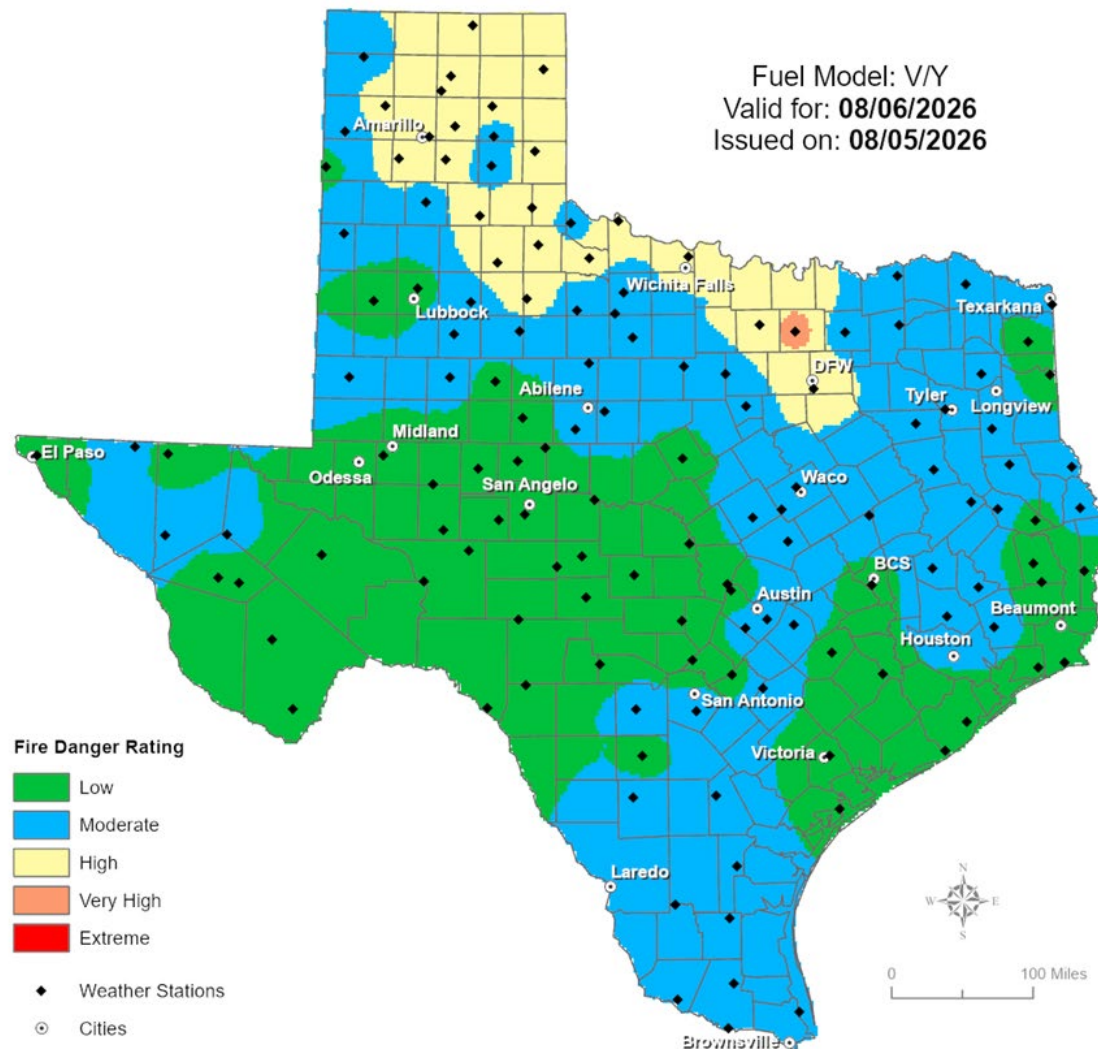

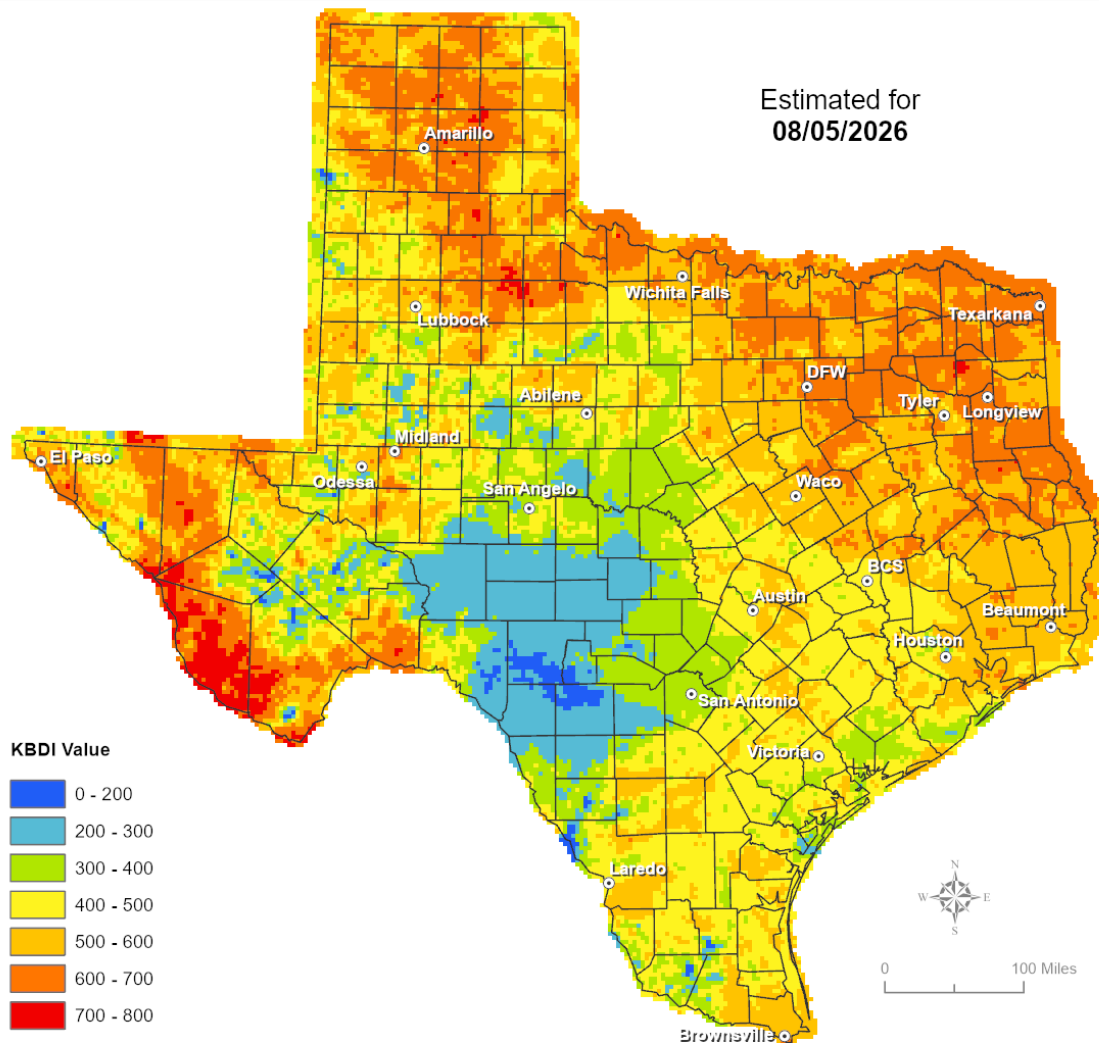

Keetch-Byram Drought Index

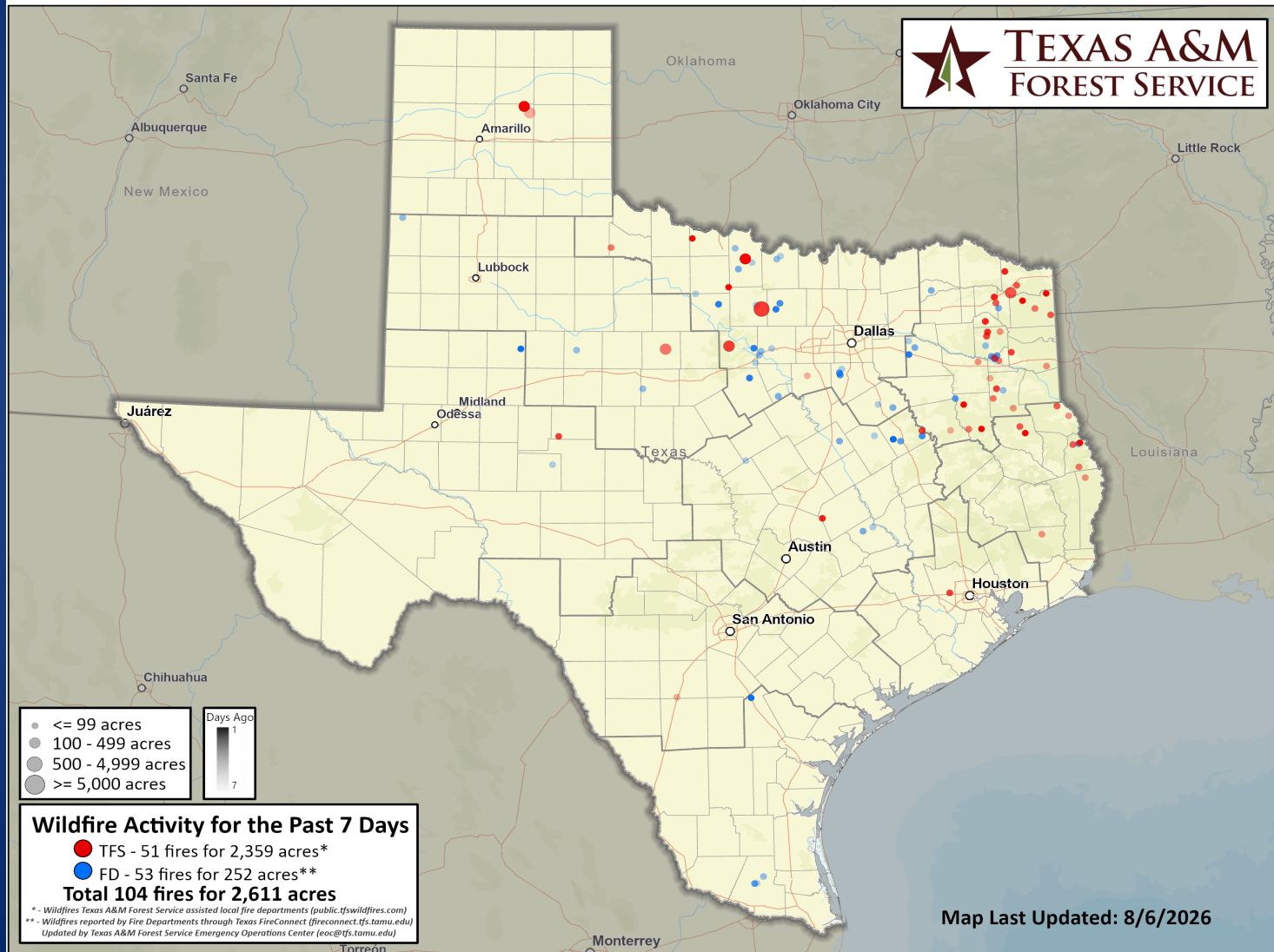

Report of 804 fires (+4) and 109,391 (+18) acres have been burned this year. There are 107 (+7) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list contains 211 (+5) counties with an average over 400.
