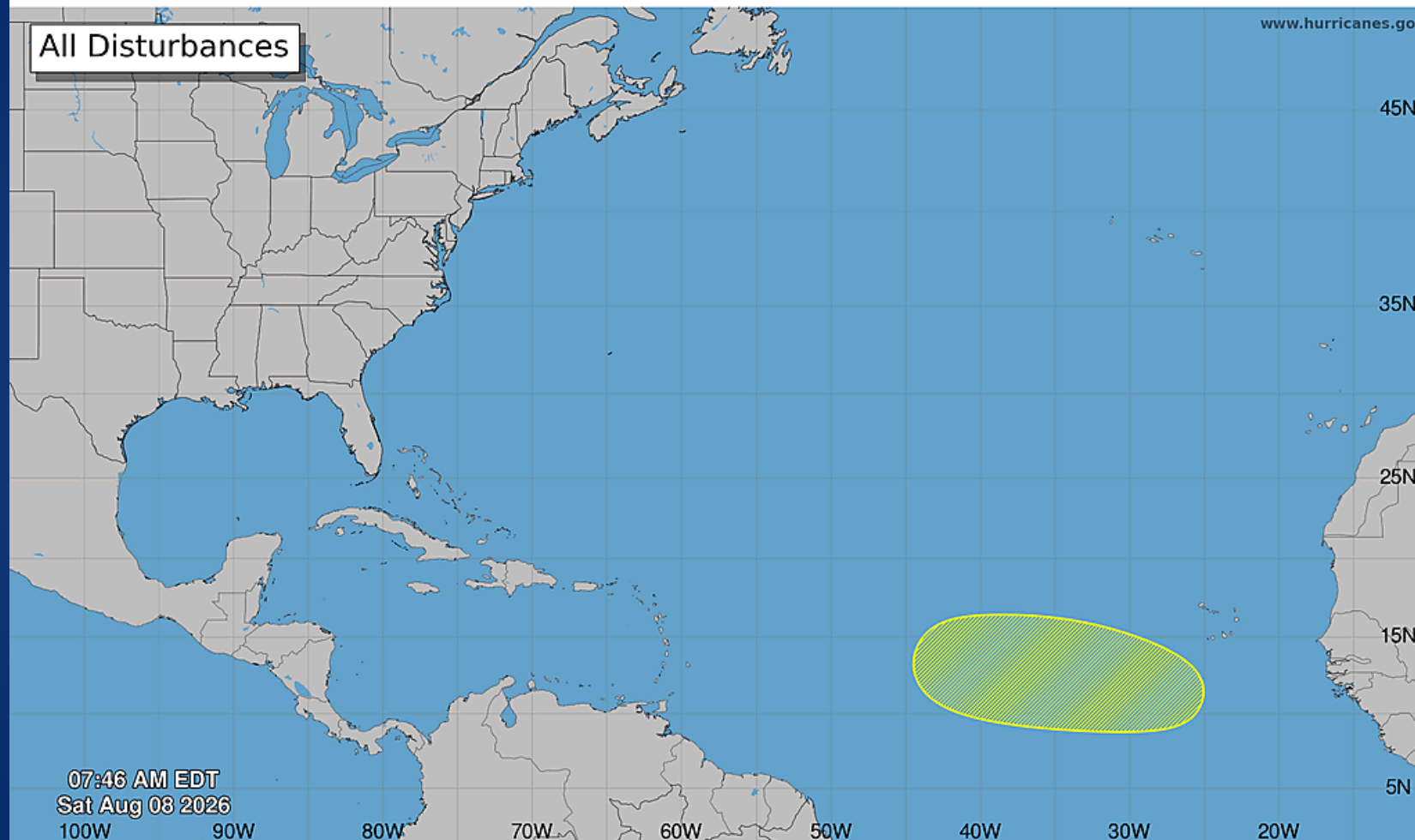
Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook

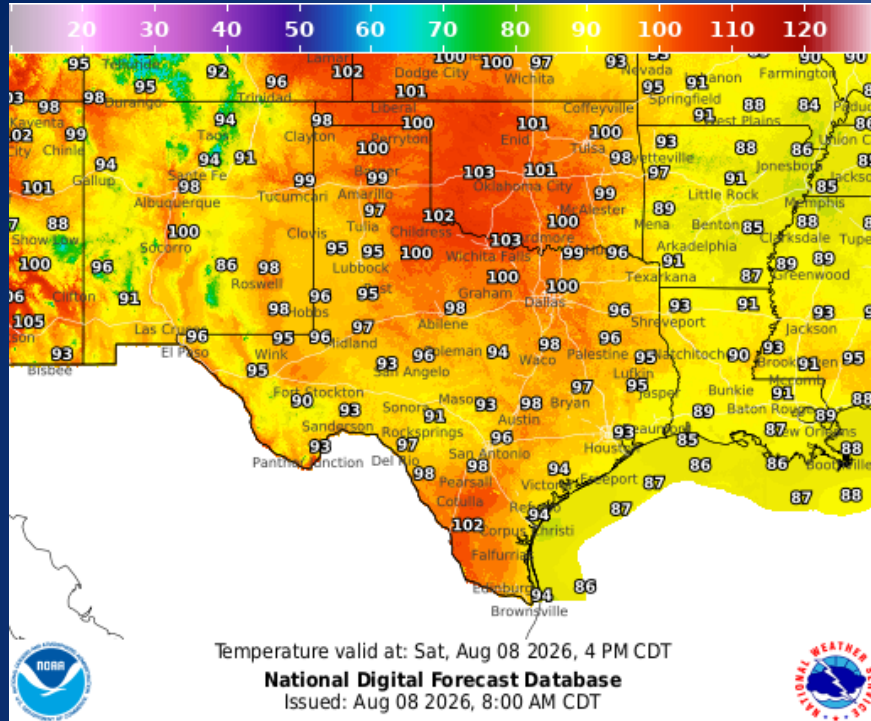

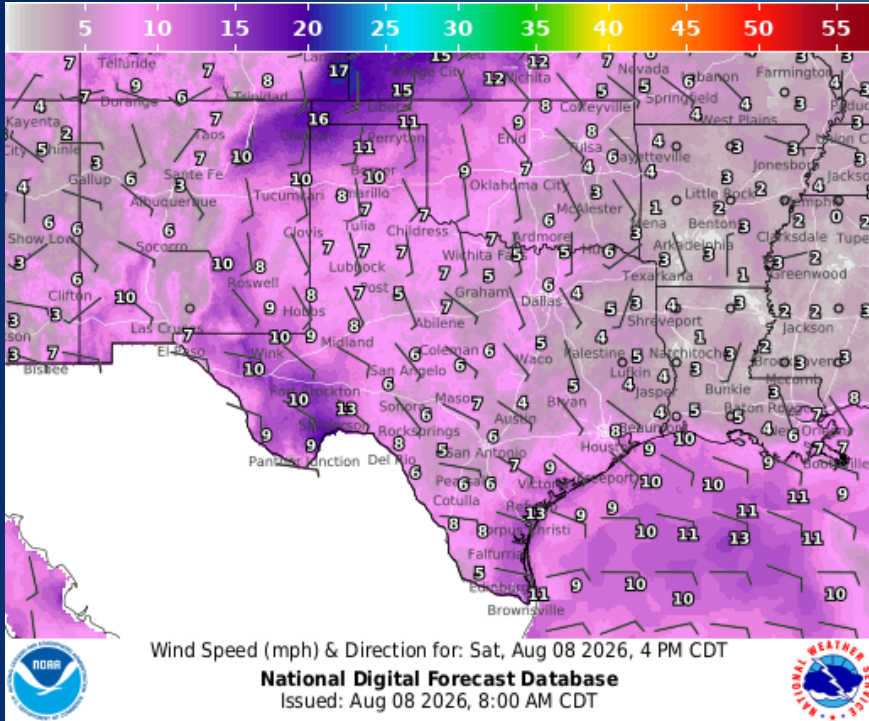

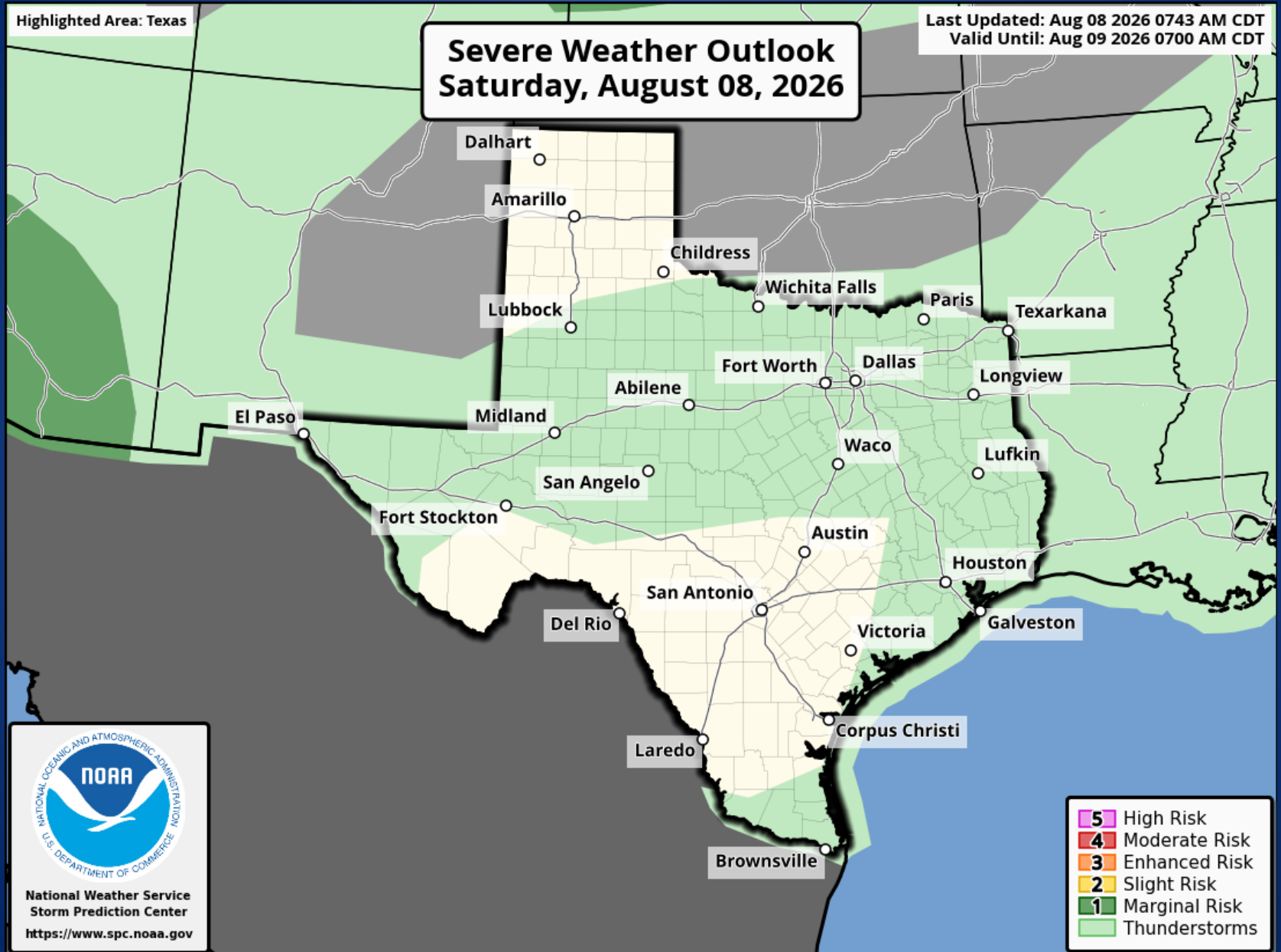

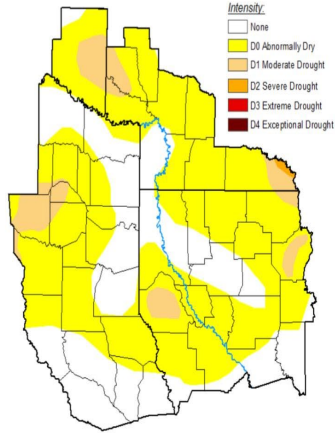

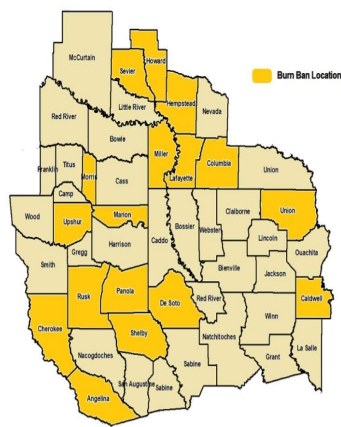
Drought Monitor across the Four State Region - (Aug. 4th, 2026)

Today: Moderate Heat Risk

Practice Heat Safety to Prevent Heat-Related Illnesses



Key Messages

- High temperatures ranging from 95-105°F this afternoon
- Peak heat indices ranging from 105-111°F
- **Moderate** (level 2 of 4) Heat Risk

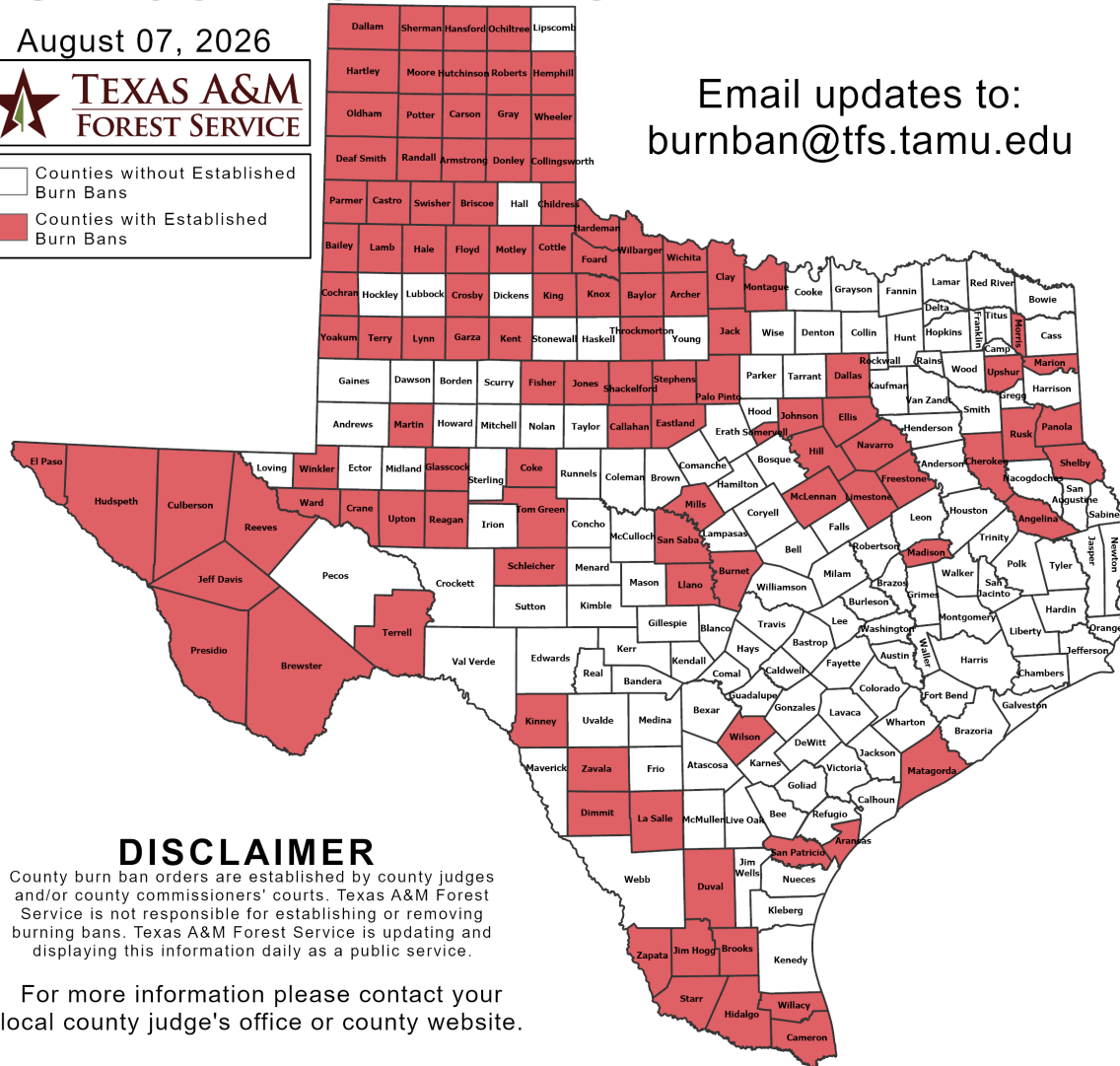

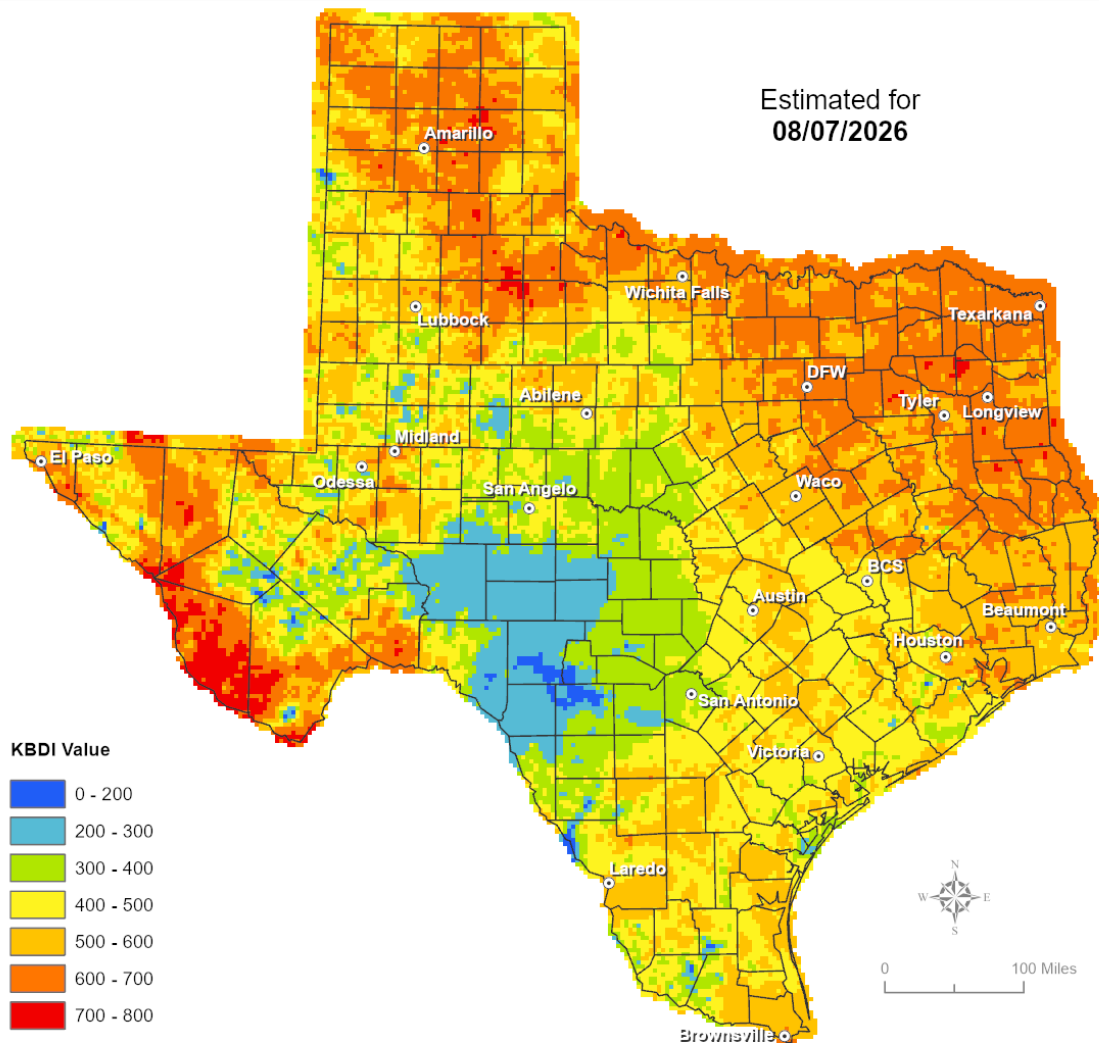
