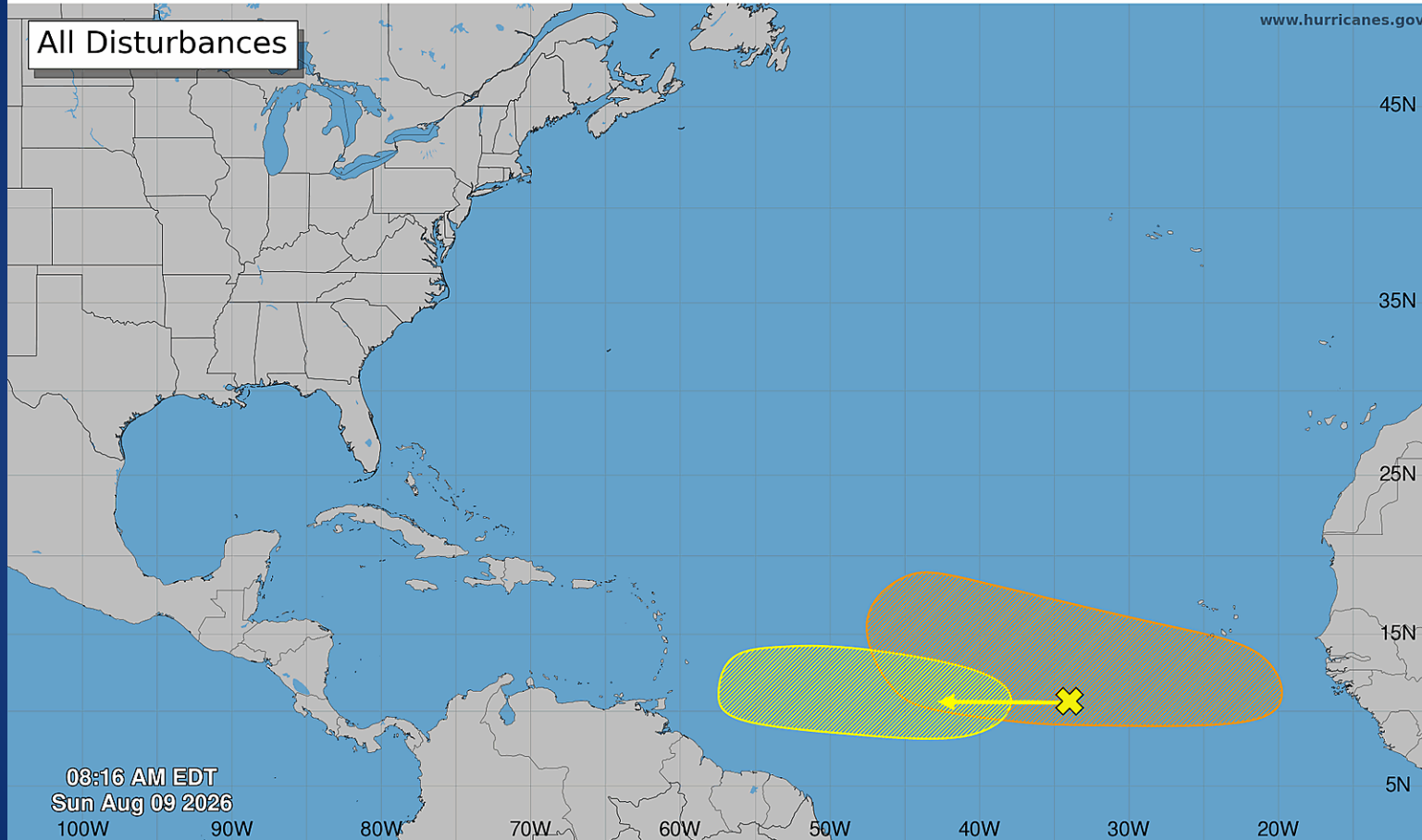


Seven-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook National Hurricane Center Miami, Florida

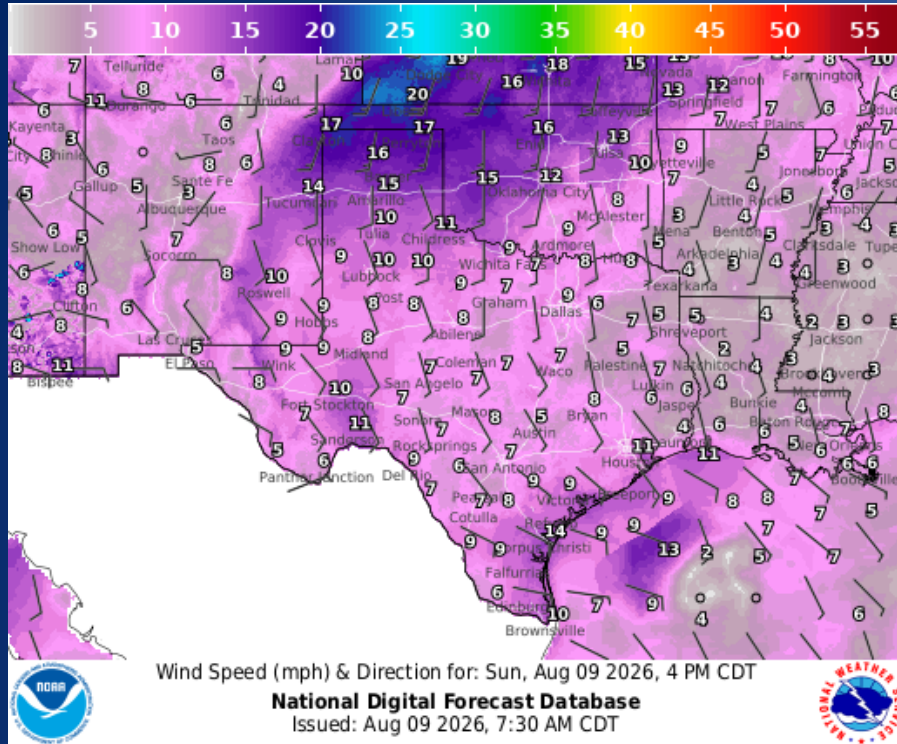

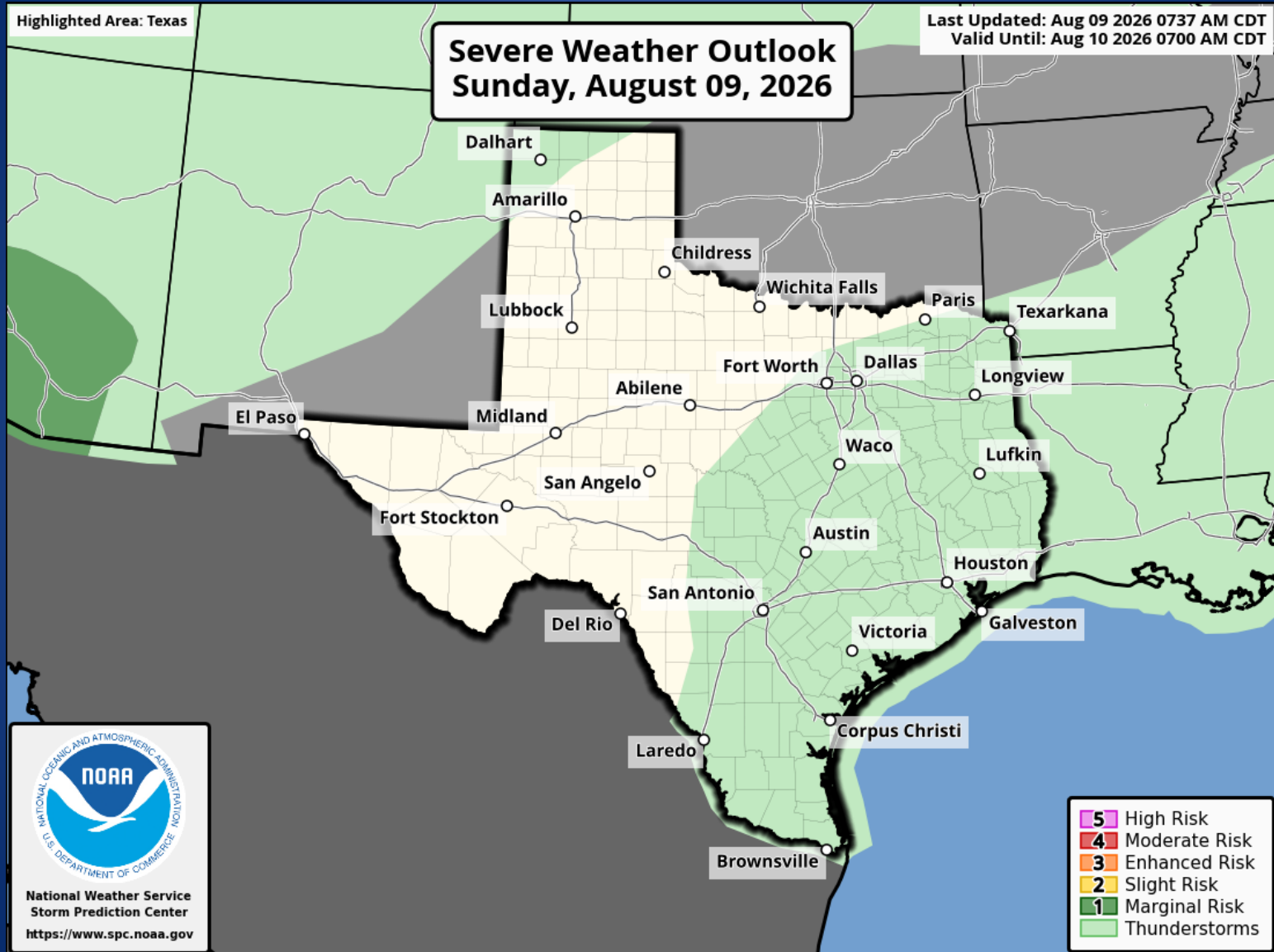

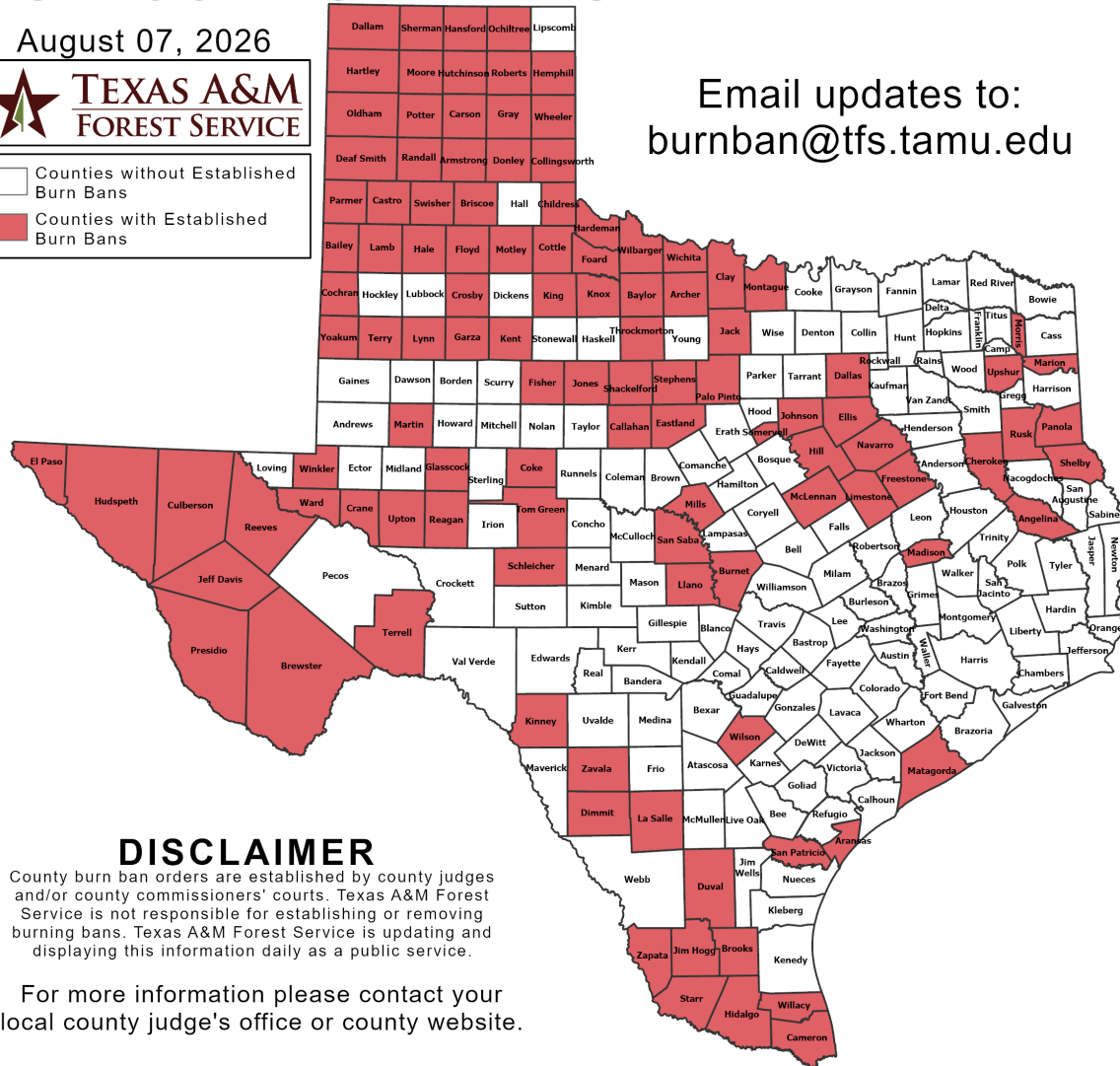

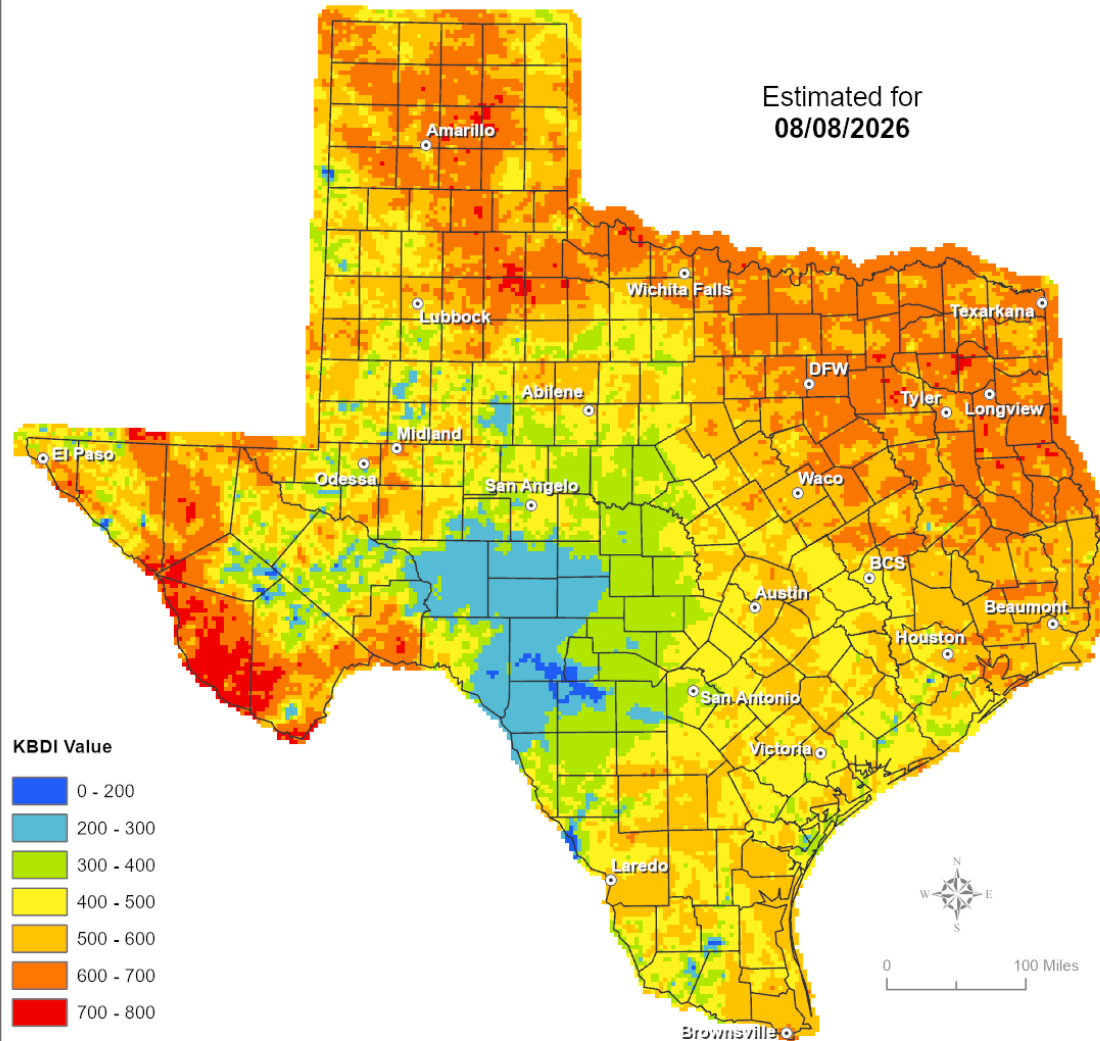
