







Light snow accumulations will continue across areas under the advisory. Slick roads will be possible, though most snow should stick to grassy surfaces.

It will be unseasonably cold today with highs in the 40s and 50s in the Permian Basin, and 60s and 70s west of the Pecos River. That is 30 degrees or more below normal for some areas and may be the last time we see temperatures near freezing anywhere in the area this season.

Coastal Flood Advisory

What: Minor coastal flooding expected

Where: Coastal Willacy, Coastal Cameron and Coastal Kenedy.

When: 10 AM to 6 PM CDT

IMPACTS: Wave run-up into the dunes will make walking difficult and driving impossible, especially around high tide (12:56 PM CDT)


Elevated easterly swells across the Western Gulf of Mexico may result in minor coastal flooding again today with wave run-up into the dunes and covering narrow beaches. The peak run-up will be around high tide, which is at around 1 PM this afternoon.





Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 76 (no change) fires and 9,595 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 69 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 36 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
