







Temperatures farther south will range from the mid and upper 30s to near 40 degrees with patchy frost areawide.





Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 76 (no change) fires and 9,595 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 66 (-3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 37 (+1) counties with an average over 400.
