



Wind Speeds











Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 91 (+4) fires and 29,111 (+260) acres destroyed this year. There are 66 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 51 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
