









Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 94 (+2) fires and 29,150 (+33) acres destroyed this year. There are 65 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 51 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
