












Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 125 (+1) fires and 39,215 (+202) acres destroyed this year. There are 70 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 25 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
