






Elevated Fire Threat on Wednesday







Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 132 (+1) fires and 39,491 (+3) acres destroyed this year. There are 78 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 52 (+9) counties with an average over 400.
