





## Severe Weather Outlook Thursday, June 11, 2020



# Hazardous Weather



Elevated fire weather conditions will be found across the Oklahoma Panhandle and the northern, southwest, and south-central Texas Panhandle. Highs are expected to be in the 90's.



Thunderstorms will be possible across the Oklahoma Panhandle and the northern Texas Panhandle this afternoon and tonight. Strong wind gusts to around 50 mph and small hail will be possible. Lightning may also cause fire starts.

# Hazardous Weather



The western portion of Eddy county and part of the Guadalupe Mountains are under a Marginal Risk for severe weather this afternoon and evening. Strong winds and lightning will be the main threat for today during any thunderstorms. Be situationally aware!




Expect hot and dry conditions today, with highs in the low to mid 90s, sunny skies and southeast winds around 10-15 mph. Elevated fire weather conditions will occur across the western Concho Valley and western Edwards Plateau this afternoon and early evening.





# Keetch-Byram Drought Index



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 139 (+7) fires and 42,209 (+2,718) acres destroyed this year. There are 78 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 61 (+9) counties with an average over 400.
