









Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 139 (no change) fires and 42,209 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 79 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 63 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
