

(Sun Jun 14 2020 09Z)








## Severe Weather Outlook Saturday, June 13, 2020

Reports 150 (+11) fires and 42,209 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 80 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 70 (+7) counties with an average over 400.
