








# Hazardous Weather





# Keetch-Byram Drought Index



# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 150 (no change) fires and 46,542 (+4,333) acres destroyed this year. There are 80 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 77 (+7) counties with an average over 400.
