







Observed Fire Danger







Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 150 (no change) fires and 46,542 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 79 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 84 (+7) counties with an average over 400.
