







Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 169 (+19) fires and 52,613 (+6,071) acres destroyed this year. There are 80 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 93 (+9) counties with an average over 400.
