



Gusts

Hazardous Weather



Isolated thunderstorms will be possible later this afternoon and into tonight mainly west of I-27. Locally heavy rain, gusty winds, and small hail, will be the primary hazards. A damaging wind event or two with gusts up to 60 mph will be possible.



Parts of SE New Mexico and the Upper Trans Pecos are under a SLIGHT risk today. Greatest threats will be strong wind gusts and isolated large hail.

Hazardous Weather



A slow-moving line of storms will produce locally heavy rainfall west of I-35 of 2 to 4 inches, with isolated amounts greater than 5 inches through this morning. The slow movement of storms, combined with a very moisture-rich atmosphere, previous rounds of heavier rainfall since last Friday, storms training over the same areas, and saturated soils is creating an increasing threat for flooding or flash flooding across this area. Be aware of this during the morning commute this morning and remember not to bypass barriers or cross flooding roads. Turn around, don't drown! It can save your life.





Reports 204 (+13) fires and 59,658 (+6,175) acres destroyed this year. There are 84 (+1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch – Byram Drought Index list 123 (-1) counties with an average over 400.
