




Wind Speeds


Mostly cloudy skies are expected today with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms. High temperatures will be around 90 degrees.







Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Reports 210 (+2) fires and 61,239 (+100) acres destroyed this year. There are 85 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 74 (-4) counties with an average over 400.
