





# Hazardous Weather



Temperatures will be 3 to 7 degrees above normal with highs ranging from the mid 90s in the Hill Country to near 103 along the Rio Grande. Elevated heat index values in the 101 to 108 degree range are possible, especially along and east of I-35.



Hot and humid conditions are expected today, with only isolated showers and thunderstorms possible this afternoon over Southern Oklahoma, portions of Southwest Arkansas, and the northeast sections of Northcentral Louisiana. When combined with the humidity, heat indices will range from 102 to 105 degrees.

- Hot temperatures and high humidity may cause heat illnesses to occur.






