



Rain Chances



Another hot day today. Be cautious with any outdoor activities in today's heat, especially if you are venturing into the Canyon today.








Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Reports 257 (+2) fires and 92,338 (+194) acres destroyed this year. There are 110 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 203 (no change) counties with an average over 400.
