



Tropical Weather Awareness



For the North Atlantic...Caribbean Sea and the Gulf of Mexico: The National Hurricane Center is issuing advisories on Tropical Storm Gonzalo, located about 900 miles east of the southern Windward Islands. The National Hurricane Center is also issuing advisories on Tropical Depression Eight, located over the central Gulf of Mexico. Tropical cyclone formation is not expected during the next five days.














Isolated showers and thunderstorms are expected this afternoon. Most locations will remain dry.




Conditions will remain humid overnight with thunderstorms dissipating after dark.




Not as hot today. Isolated to scattered thunderstorms will be possible this afternoon. Locally damaging winds will be the main hazard, along with patchy blowing dust.

Hazardous Weather



Shows and thunderstorms will continue across the area on Thursday. The rain over the past few days has saturated the ground in many locations which could result in flooding during periods of heavy rain. Gusty winds and small hail are still a possibility in the forecast. Max temperatures will be generally in the upper 80s to the mid 90s across the region, except in area mountains where highs will be in the 60s to lower 70s range. Skies continue to be partly to mostly cloudy.



Near-average temperatures expected today. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected across much of the area. Storms may contain strong outflow winds, brief heavy rain, and cloud to ground lightning.



Overnight: Scattered showers and thunderstorms along the coast and along and south of I-10. Lows in the mid 70s with easterly winds around 5-10 mph.


Hot With Isolated Thunderstorms

Isolated showers and thunderstorms are possible today across most of South Central Texas with the exception of the far southwest. Coverage will likely be limited and most will continue to miss out on needed rainfall. A mix of clouds and sun east, more sunshine near the Rio Grande with near normal temperatures.

Hazardous Weather



The combination of hot temperatures and high humidity will produce dangerous heat conditions this afternoon across South Texas. Afternoon heat index values of 110 to 112 degrees can be expected over the inland Coastal Bend. The afternoon heat index values will range from 105 to 109 across the rest of south Texas.




Isolated showers and thunderstorms will be possible today across the coastal plains. Otherwise, it will be very warm again today with highs ranging from near 90 along the coast to 103 degrees over the western Brush Country. Afternoon heat index values will range from 105 to 112 degrees today.


