





Isolated thunderstorms are possible from midday through sunset across all but areas north of I-20 and west of I-35W. No severe weather is expected across the area. Otherwise, highs will range from the upper 80s to mid 90s. East-southeast winds 5-15 mph can be expected under partly to mostly cloudy skies.




Showers and thunderstorms are expected as spiral banding associated with weakening Tropical Storm Hanna in northern Mexico move through the area. Highs will be in the mid 80s with east and southeast winds 5 to 15 mph.

Expect more showers and thunderstorms across the area today. Flash flooding will be possible where heavy showers develop. Temperatures will be cool with highs in the mid 80s.



Tropical Storm Hanna continues to move west across Deep South Texas. We can expect see Tropical Storm force winds, heavy rainfall and flash flooding with this system.

Overview:

- Tropical Storm Hanna continues to move westward through Deep South Texas.
- A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect Cameron, Willacy, Kenedy, Brooks, Starr, Hidalgo and Zapata counties, as well as Laguna Madre and Gulf waters.
- A Storm Surge Warning remains in effect for coastal Kenedy County.

Local Threats/Impacts:

- Heavy rainfall and flash flooding.
- Tropical Storm force winds will cause power outages and damage to buildings and trees.
- Minor beach flooding and dangerous rip currents.
- High seas on the Gulf waters.






Keetch-Byram Drought Index

Reports 277 (no change) fires and 93,667 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 114 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 222 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
