




## Rain Chances: Noon thru 6PM Monday



Reports 277 (no change) fires and 93,668 (+1) acres destroyed this year. There are 114 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 207 (-15) counties with an average over 400.
