




Wind Speeds

- Up to 98° mountains, 102° foothills, Marfa Plateau, and central Brewster County, 106° plains, and 112° along the Rio Grande.


Heat Safety



Flood Watch is in effect in green.




Flash Flood Watch remains in effect until 1P.M. CDT for all the counties in shown green.





08/12/20	Fire Danger Statement	Crane, Ector, Glasscock, Midland, Pecos, Reagan, Terrell, Upton, Ward and Winkler Counties; Across Parts of West Texas Trans Pecos, Central and Southern Permian Basin and Stockton Plateau
08/12/20	Grass Fire Danger Statement	Bell, Bosque, Comanche, Coryell, Eastland, Erath, Hamilton, Hood, Jack, Lampasas, Mills, Palo Pinto, Parker, Somervell, Stephens, Wise and Young Counties; Along and West of a Line from Bowie to Temple

Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 331 (+8) fires and 104,015 (+3,715) acres destroyed this year. There are 126 (+2) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 216 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
