





Severe Weather Outlook Tuesday, August 25, 2020



Hazardous Weather



A mostly sunny and hot day is expected today (Tuesday) with high temperatures in the mid and upper 90s. A few showers and thunderstorms are possible across the east in the afternoon. An east to northeast wind will prevail between 5 and 10 mph.



Partly cloudy and hot with highs in the mid to upper 90s and near 100 degrees along the Rio Grande. Isolated thunderstorms are forecast for parts of the Edwards Plateau and Rio Grande this afternoon. If storms do form, they may be capable of producing strong wind gusts up to 40 mph.







Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 429 (+10) fires and 118,124 (2,055) acres destroyed this year. There are 141 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch-Byram Drought Index list 239 (+2) counties with an average over 400.
