




Hazardous Weather



Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 482 (no change) fires and 134,172 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 144 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 182 (-17) counties with an average over 400.
