





# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 485 (no change) fires and 134,310 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 139 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 178 (-3) counties with an average over 400.
