











Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 485 (no change) fires and 134,310 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 139 (- 6) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 178 (-3) counties with an average over 400.
