
Five-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook







There may be some thunderstorms this afternoon and evening, mainly across the Davis Mountains, Marfa Plateau, and Big Bend Area, though no severe weather is expected. While there will be sunshine today, you may notice some haze out there due to smoke from wildfires across the western US.


Afternoon Isolated Showers and Thunderstorms Coastal Bend




Increasing cloudiness and mild tonight. Isolated to scattered showers and thunderstorms expected to approach the coast from offshore.



Fire Danger Forecast




Keetch-Byram Drought Index
