



Tropical or Sub-Tropical Cyclone: Depression Storm Hurricane





Minor Coastal Flooding Possible

Mainly Around Times of High Tide

Isolated minor coastal flooding is expected to occur through Wednesday morning, mainly around times of high tide. Elevated water levels may also occur across the Laguna Madre and South Bay, and along State Highway 4 west of Boca Chica State Park. An upgrade to a Coastal Flood Advisory may be needed later today as swells from Tropical Storm Sally begin arriving.




Look for numerous showers and thunderstorms across deep south Texas today. Some locally heavy rainfall is possible and some minor flooding may occur in low spots and poor drainage areas. Highs today will be in the 80s under cloudy skies. Winds will generally remain from the northeast at 10 to 20 mph.





Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 487 (no change) fires and 134,570 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 114 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 131 (+3) counties with an average over 400.
