




Severe Weather Outlook Tuesday, September 22, 2020

A Tropical Storm Warning remains in effect for Lavaca and DeWitt Counties. Tropical Storm conditions from Beta will be possible Tuesday with winds gusting up to 40 mph.




A Coastal Flood Warning remains in effect for the entire coast through this afternoon as water levels remain high. Waters levels are expected to decrease during this afternoon.



A Flash Flood Watch remains in effect for the Victoria Crossroads through 7 PM this evening. Additional heavy rainfall could result in flooding.

Hazardous Weather




A Coastal Flood Warning is in effect until Noon CDT today. Leftover swell from Tropical Storm Beta will cause water levels to reach around 2 feet above ground level, leading to the impacts outlined above.




