





## Severe Weather Outlook Monday, September 28, 2020



# Hazardous Weather




A Wind Advisory is in effect through 1PM today. North to north-northeast winds at 20 to 30 mph are expected, with gusts 35 to 45 mph in some areas.



Strong north winds will occur behind a cold front later this morning and continue through the night into Tuesday. Gusts to near gale force will be possible over the Gulf waters tonight. Small Craft Advisory is in effect for the bays until 1 AM Tuesday, for the near shore waters until 10 AM Tuesday, and for the offshore waters until 1 PM Tuesday.

# Hazardous Weather




A Small Craft Advisory is in effect from 10 am today to 12 pm Tuesday. A strong cold front will swing through the area bringing strong northerly winds and high seas leading to hazardous marine conditions.







Reports 491 (no change) fires and 134,651 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 84 (-1) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 109 (+8) counties with an average over 400.
