





Hazardous Weather

Low Rain Chances North Of I-20 Tonight

An upper level system and cool front cross the Red River late this evening

A strong storm or two containing small hail possible between 10 pm - 2 am

An upper disturbance and associated surface cold front arrive later tonight. Scattered showers and isolated storms are expected mainly north of I-20.

Severe weather is NOT expected, but a brief strong storm or two with small hail is possible around midnight within the yellow hatched area.

As the cold front moves south I-20 and the upper system moves east away from the area overnight, strength and coverage of storms will lessen.

A cold front will bring a chance for scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms to areas mainly north of I-20 later this evening and during the overnight. No severe weather is expected. However, a brief strong storm or two possibly containing small hail cannot be ruled out between 10 am and 2 am Sunday morning across a small area near the immediate Red River Valley. Rain and storm chances will lessen during the pre-dawn areas, as stronger lift exits the area and the cold front begins moving into Central Texas. Low temperatures will range from the mid 50s to the lower 60s across the region.







Keetch-Byram Drought Index



Fire Activity (*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 499 (+3) fires and 135,060 (+15) acres destroyed this year. There are 83 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 125 (+7) counties with an average over 400.
