






Minor coastal flooding will be possible this evening into late tonight, especially around the time of high tide at 10:43 pm, where tidal run up could reach to the dunes.







# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 502 (+3) fires and 135,092 (+32) acres destroyed this year. There are 80 (-3) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 134 (+5) counties with an average over 400.
