


## Five-Day Graphical Tropical Weather Outlook











# Fire Activity (\*Last 24 Hours)

Reports 506 (no change) fires and 135,148 (no change) acres destroyed this year. There are 80 (no change) counties with burn bans. The Keetch–Byram Drought Index list 155 (+4) counties with an average over 400.
