**STATEWIDE CURRENT SITUATION:** Power restoration was completed in Jefferson County on Thursday.

#### OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES:

1. Protect life and property.
2. Support rapid & effective response.
3. Collect and disseminate accurate incident information to improve decision-making.
4. Accurately track incident costs associated with assigned resources for cost recovery.

#### RESPONDING STATE AGENCIES/ORGANIZATIONS REPORTS

**Texas Division of Emergency Management, Texas A&M University System (TDEM):** The State of Texas State Operations Center (SOC) remains at Readiness Level II Escalated Response Conditions, Daily Operations staff continues to process disaster declarations, letters to the Governor, Disaster Summary Outlines, State of Texas Assistance Requests (STARs), as well as preparing Snapshots and the State SITREP. The State Management Team (SMT) continues conducting operations in the alternate State Operations Center, working together with activated members of the State's Emergency Management Council. TDEM District Coordinators are working closely with their local emergency management partners to assist with any unmet needs and resources.

#### Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ):

##### Drinking Water Systems Assessments:

Phone assessments have been completed for all 79 drinking water systems in Jefferson and Orange Counties. On Monday, staff conducted follow up calls to the drinking water systems in Jefferson and Orange Counties.

- Of the 79 systems assessed, 72 are operational, 1 is not operational and 1 is unknown (called but no contact).
- 1 of the operational systems is on generators.
- The 1 system that is not operational is out due to loss of power.
- 10 systems are under a Boil Water Notice.

**Wastewater Facilities Assessments:**

Phone assessments have been completed for the 28 of the 31 wastewater systems in Jefferson and Orange Counties.

- Of the 31 systems assessed, all 31 are operational.
- 2 of the systems are on generators.

One Continuous Ambient Monitoring Station remains without power.

**Texas Public Utilities Commission (PUC):** Entergy Texas had over 2,000 resources engaged in the power restoration. Entergy is reporting they should have all power restored by Thursday October 15.
